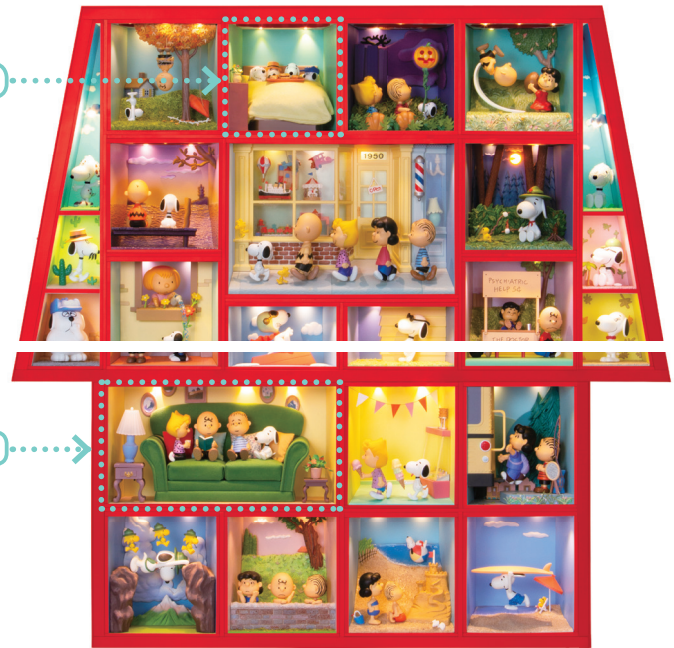

### FLOWERPOT

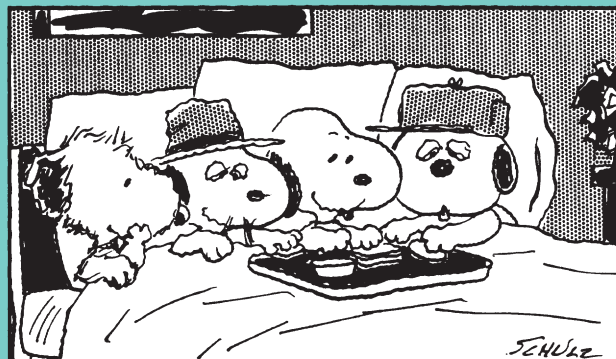

Making the Flowerpot

Let's assemble the Bed in the【3 Brothers】scene and decorate it with the Bedspread made in issue 9. We will also make the Flowerpot on the Side Table on the right of the【Relaxing at Home】scene.

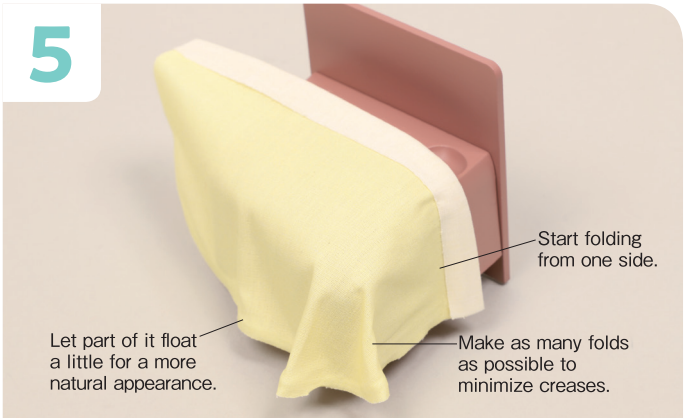

Assembling the Bed

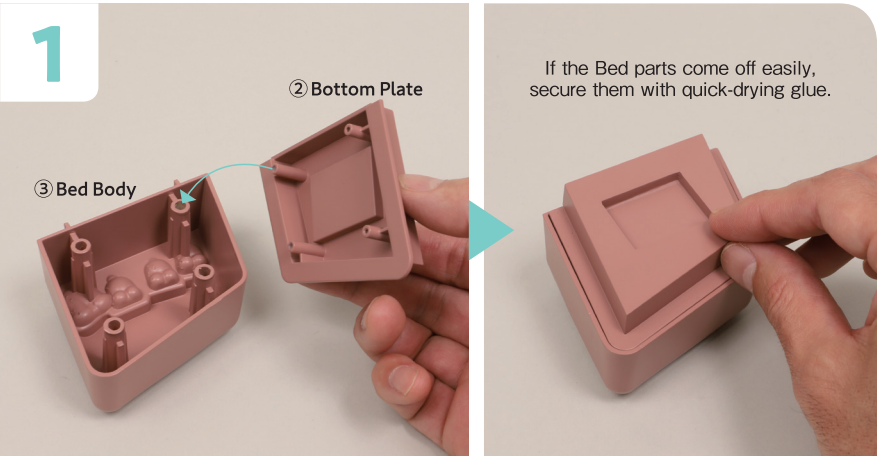


Start folding the Bedspread from one side and make it look natural while pasting it around the Bed Body. Fold the corners as much as possible to minimize creases and let part of the bottom edge float a little for a more natural appearance.

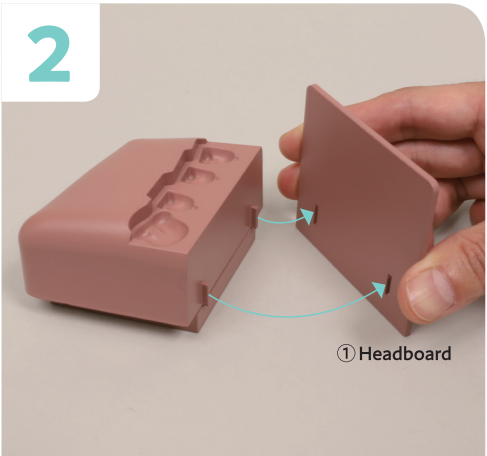


Fold to balance the other side of the Bedspread as in step 5.

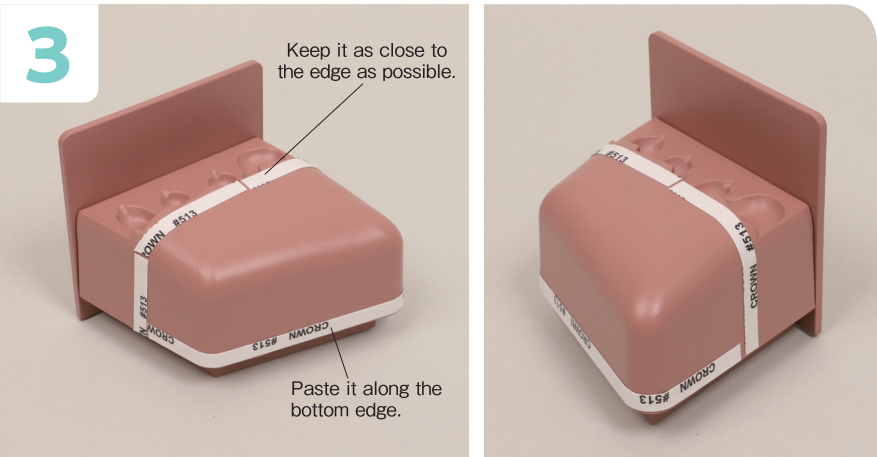
ASSEMBLING THE BED



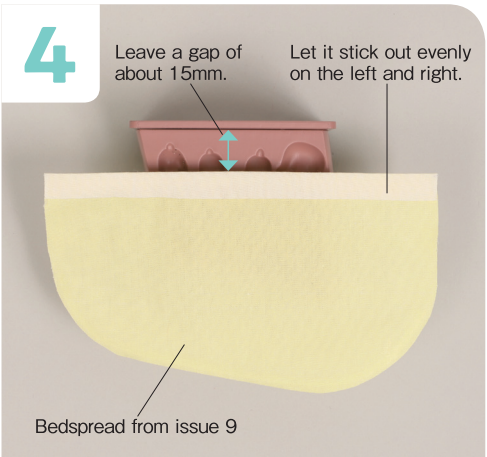
Assemble the back of the ③ Bed Body with the ② Bottom Plate. Insert the four protrusions of the ② Bottom Plate all the way into the holes of the ③ Bed Body.



Assemble the ① Headboard with the ③ Bed Body by inserting the protrusions of the ③ Bed Body into the holes of the ① Headboard.



Attach the Bedspread from issue 9 with the Bed Body. First, paste double-sided tapes around the Bed Body as shown.



Peel off the backing papers of the double-sided tapes and paste the Bedspread from issue 9 as shown.



Issue 10 Completed

The Bed is now complete. Refer to the instructions on the right to display the figurine in the indentation.

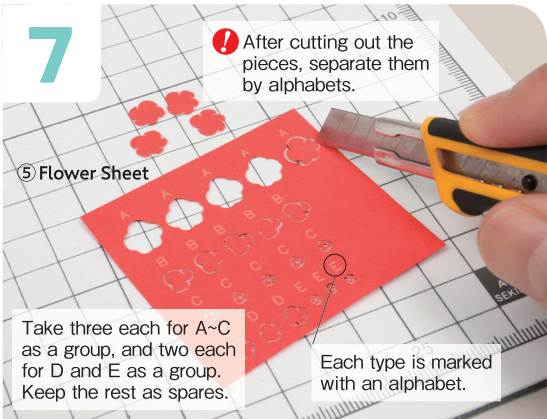


Let's decorate it with figurines

The indentations on the Bed Body are for displaying the figurines. The rightmost indentation is for Olaf from issue 9 while the leftmost indentation is for Andy from issue 8.



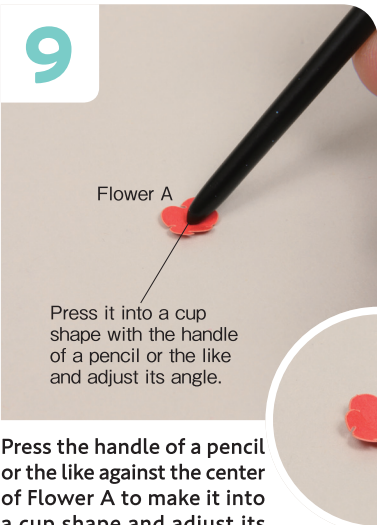
MAKING THE FLOWERPOT



Use a cutter to cut and remove Flowers A~E from the joints of the ⑤ Flower Sheet. Once cut, separate them by alphabets so you will not mix up the types.



Remove Leaves F, G and H from the ④ Leaf Sheet in the same way.



Press the handle of a pencil or the like against the center of Flower A to make it into a cup shape and adjust its angle as shown.

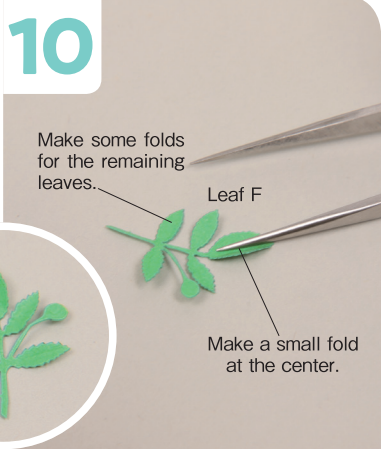

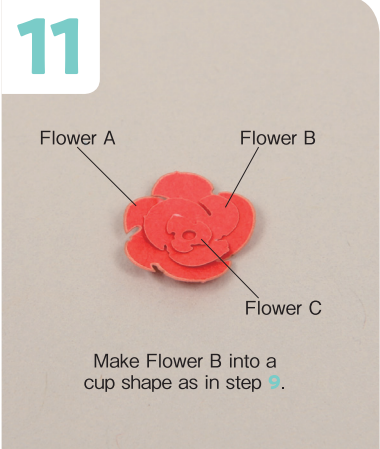

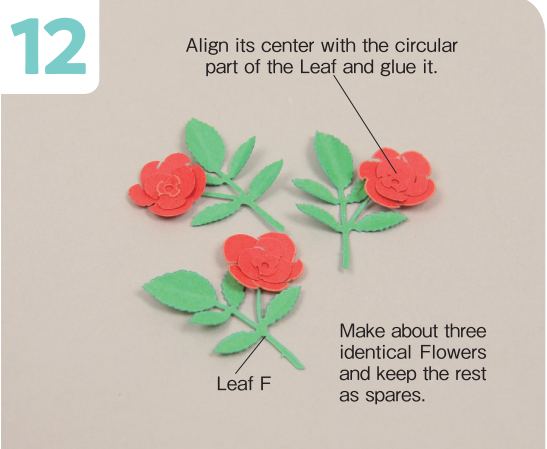
Making the Flowerpot



Make a small fold at the center of Leaf F by pressing Tweezers against its center.



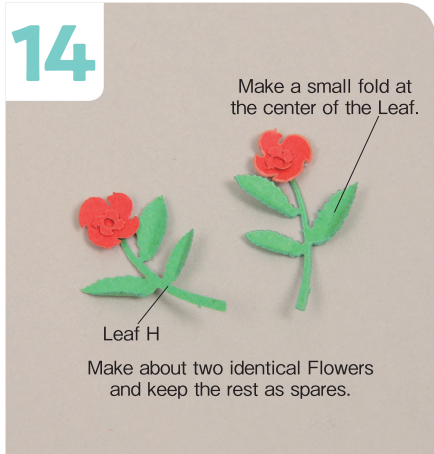
Glue Flowers A, B and C together.



We will now glue the Flower made in step 11 onto Leaf F. Glue the center of the Flower to the circular part of Leaf F. You will need about three of the same Flower.



Now glue Flowers D and E together to make a smaller flower.



Glue the Flower from step 13 onto leaf H as in step 12. You will need about two of the same Flower.



Do not glue any Flowers on Leaf G. You will need about three Leaves.



Apply plenty of water-soluble wood glue into the ⑥ Flowerpot.

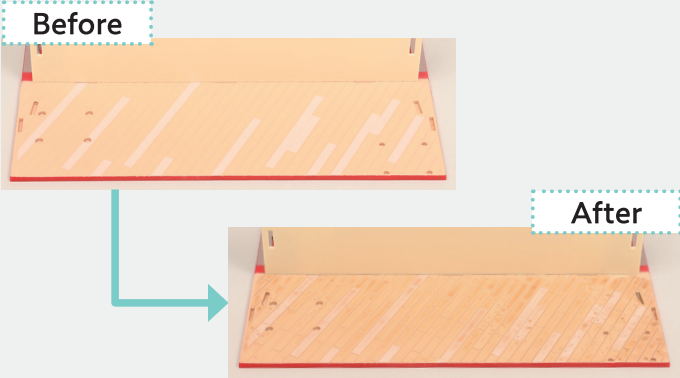


When the glue starts to dry a little, insert Leaf F from step 12, Leaf H from step 14 and Leaf G from step 15 into the Flowerpot and balance their arrangement.

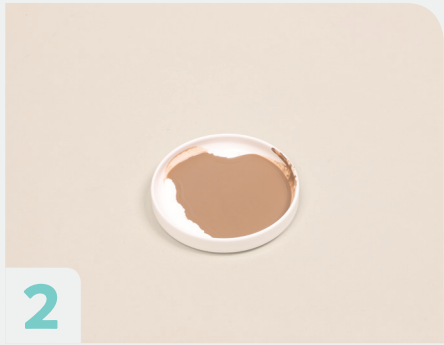


For those who wish to add extra details to their scene

The parts of each scene are provided ready to display but there are some scenes to which modellers can add extra details should they wish. When such opportunities arise, we will show you techniques to add extra decoration using acrylic gouache and other painting tools. In this scene the floor can be painted in extra shades to give it a more worn look and feel.



First, squeeze out grayish brown acrylic gouache on a palette and add about 10 times as much water.



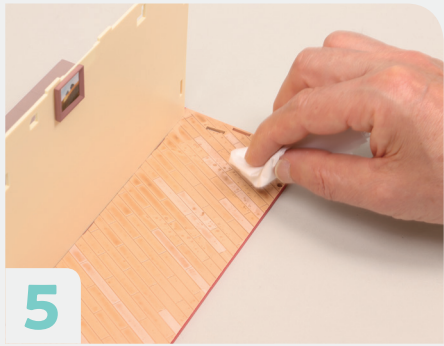
Mix well to dissolve the paint evenly.



You can also add a few drops of neutral detergent to the water-dissolved paint to replace the soap.



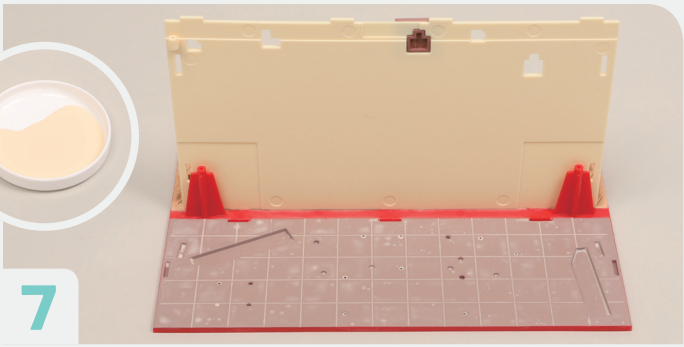
Apply the soapy acrylic gouache all over the floor of the 【Relaxing at Home】 scene. Be careful not to get paint on surfaces like the walls.



Wipe off any excess paint with tissue paper before it dries. The floor has a darker color now.



You can apply paint to some planks of the flooring several times to make the color a little darker.



For the 【Eating Together】 scene, we will dissolve 1:5 ratio of yellow ochre to white with about 10 times as much water and apply it to the floor. A thin layer of white paint will add a worn look to it.
