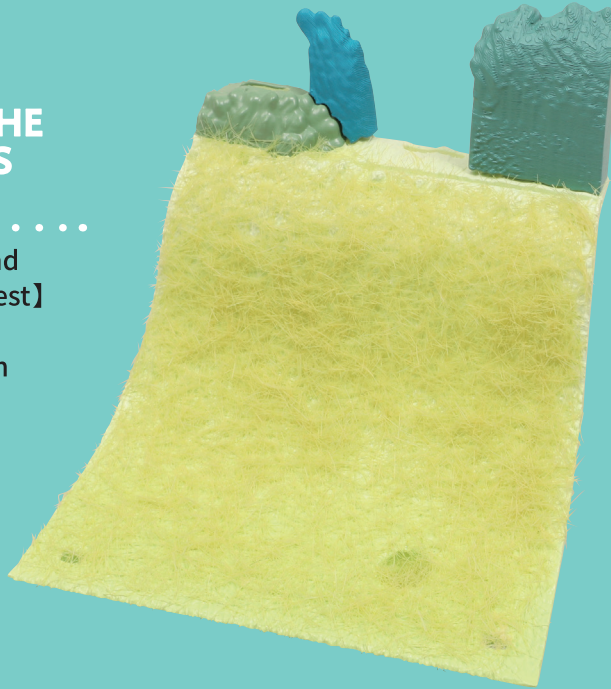

GROUND FOR THE 【WOODSTOCK'S NEST】 SCENE

We will make the Ground for the 【Woodstock's Nest】 scene (Issue 1, Page S7, Scene 4). Sprinkle green Powder on the Ground for a richer texture.

Assembling the Cabinet

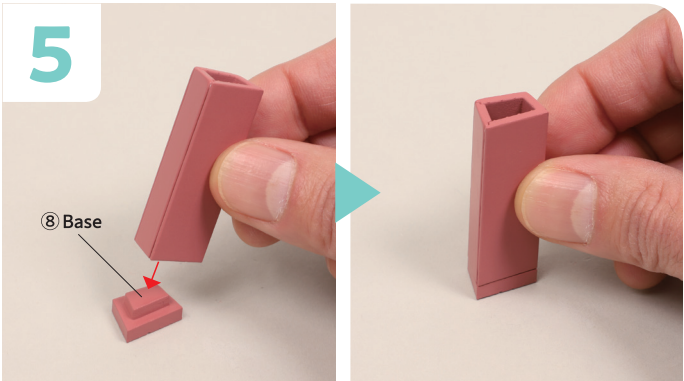
We will assemble the bedside Cabinet in the [3 Brothers] scene and make the Ground for the [Woodstock's Nest] scene. Apply water-soluble glue and sprinkle green Powder on the ground to give it a richer texture.

- ① Ground ② Grove A ③ Grove B ④ Powder ⑤ Left Panel ⑥ Cabinet Body
⑦ Top Panel ⑧ Base 【Figurine】 ⑨ Spike

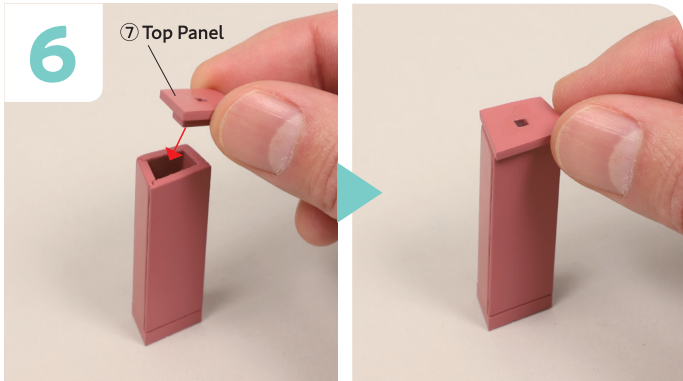

Assembling the Cabinet

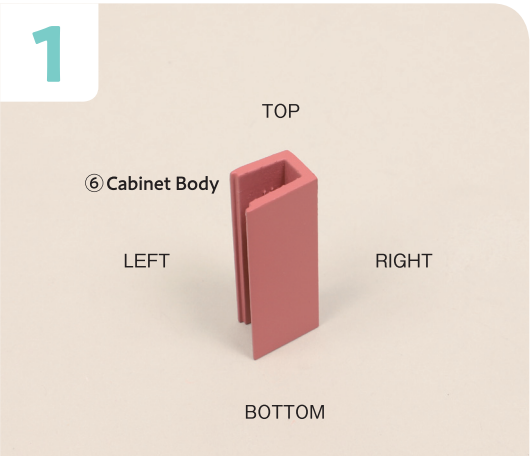


Insert the protrusion of the ⑧ Base to the bottom of the Cabinet Body assembled in step 3.

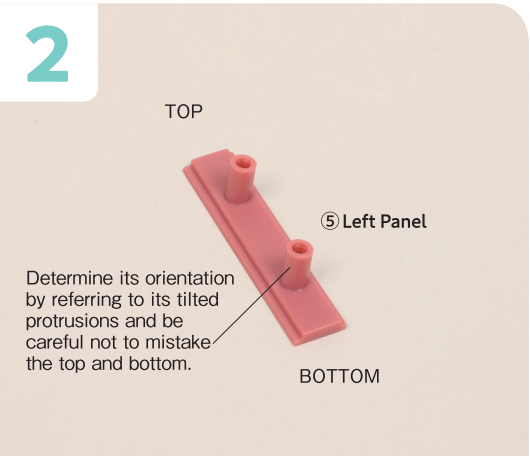


Assemble the ⑦ Top Panel to the top of the Cabinet Body in the same way. With the protrusion of the ⑦ Top Panel facing the right way, insert it into the top of the Cabinet Body.

ASSEMBLING THE CABINET



Make sure the ⑥ Cabinet Body is facing the right way.



Also check the orientation of the ⑤ Left Panel by referring to its tilted protrusions and be careful not to mistake the top and bottom.



Issue 11 Completed



The Cabinet is now complete. Please take good care of it as it will be assembled with the Floorboard in a later issue.



Let's display the figurines

If the hat comes off, secure it with a little quick-drying glue.

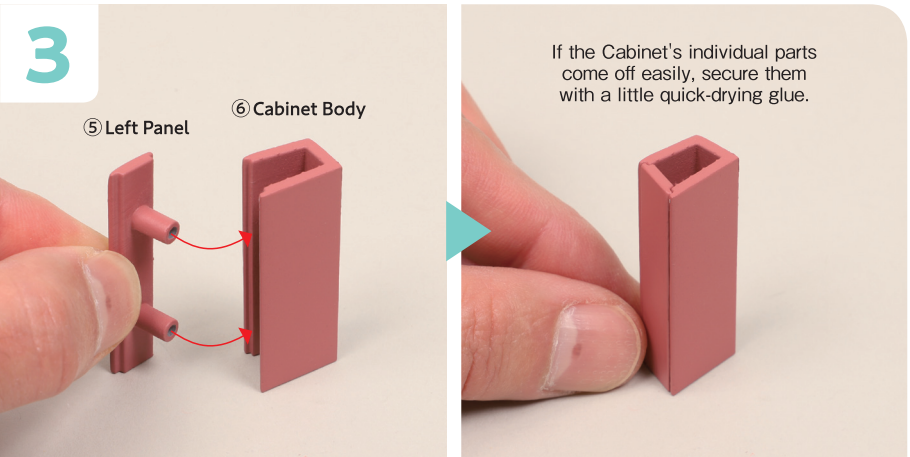


Do not glue these figurines in place yet as they need to be detached in future assemblies.

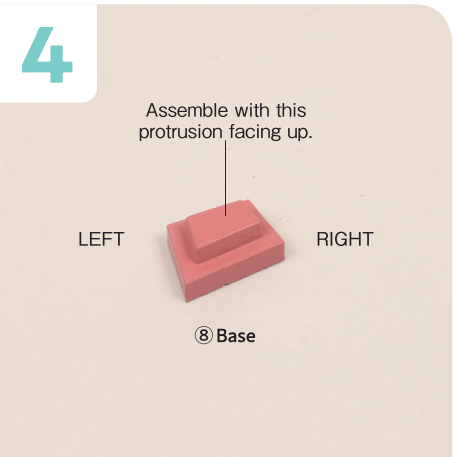


Display the ⑨ Spike figurine on the Bed in the [3 Brothers] scene by placing it in the second indentation from the left.

MAKING THE GROUND FOR THE 【WOODSTOCK'S NEST】 SCENE



Assemble the ⑤ Left Panel to the ⑥ Cabinet Body by joining its protrusions with the inner edges of the Cabinet Body.



Assemble ⑧ Base with its protrusion facing up. Determine its orientation by referring to the bevel of the protrusion.



Sprinkle green Powder all over the ① Ground except for the upper flat area.



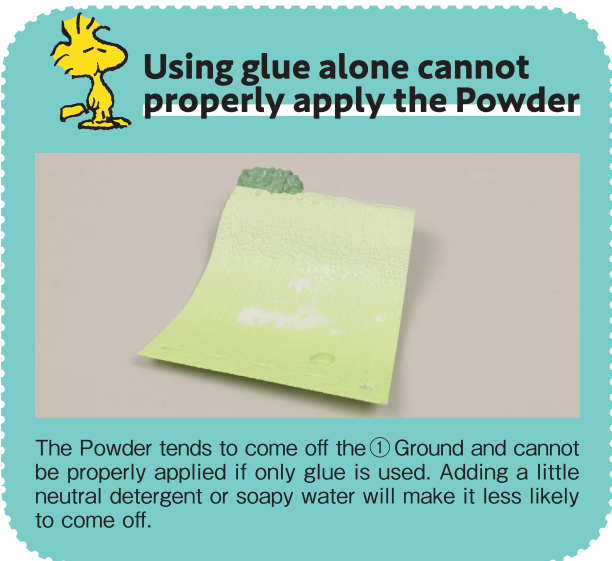
We will only use about a quarter amount of the ④ Powder in this issue. Pour out the amount of Powder required for this issue on a palette or the like.



Making the Ground for the [Woodstock's Nest] Scene



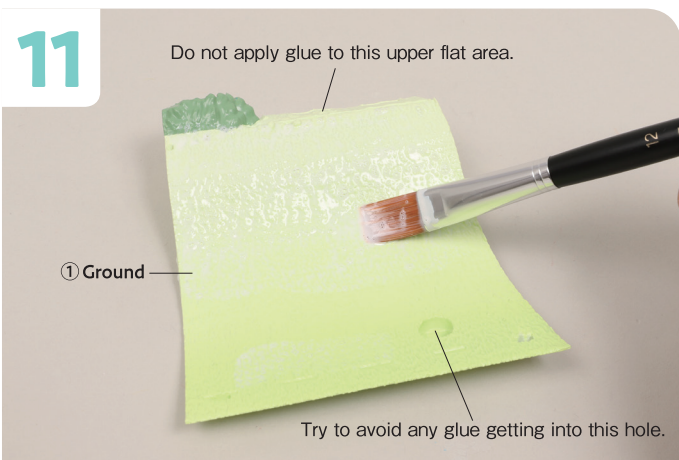
Glue the Powder with water-soluble wood glue. First, squeeze about half a teaspoon of glue on a palette, then add an equal amount of water and mix well.



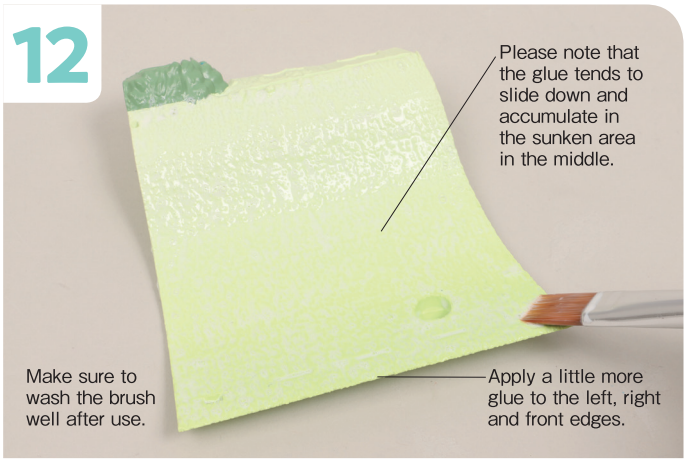
The Powder tends to come off the ① Ground and cannot be properly applied if only glue is used. Adding a little neutral detergent or soapy water will make it less likely to come off.



Add another 2~3 drops of neutral detergent and mix well. Any ordinary neutral detergent will do, or you can use soapy water instead.



Dip a brush into the glue diluted in step 10 and apply it to the ① Ground.

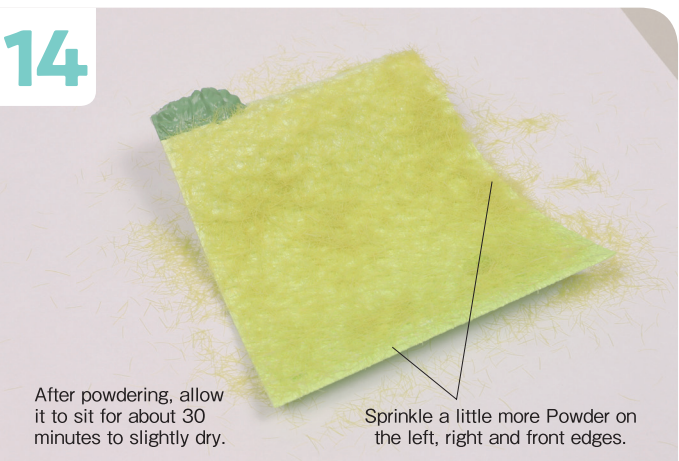


Apply the glue to the entire surface of the ① Ground as much as possible, a little more on the left, right and front edges in particular, as the Powder tends to come off there. Please also note that the glue tends to slide down and accumulate in the sunken area in the middle.

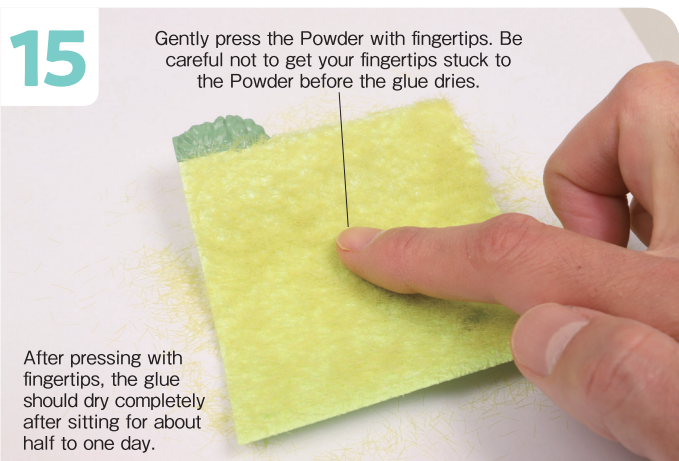


We will now sprinkle the Powder prepared in step 8. Rub to loosen the Powder with fingertips and sprinkle a little at a time.

Making the Ground for the [Woodstock's Nest] Scene



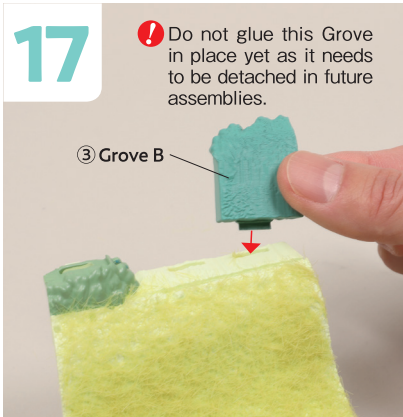
Sprinkle the Powder evenly over the entire surface in the same way, a little more on the left, right and front edges as the Powder tends to come off there. Allow it to sit for about 30 minutes to slightly dry.



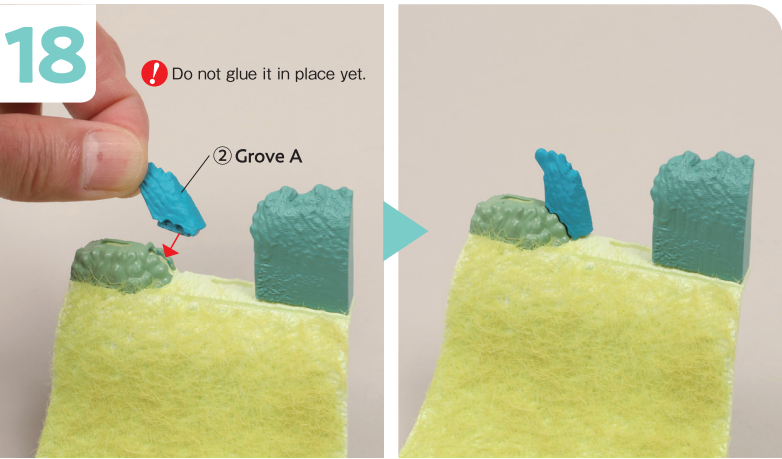
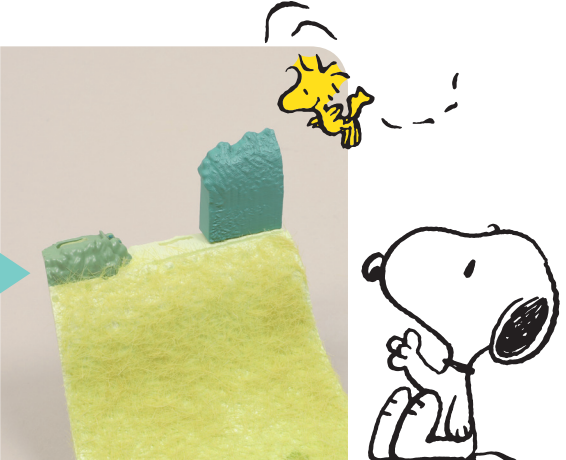
When the glue dries slightly, gently press the Powder with fingertips, then leave it for about half to one day to let the glue dry completely.



After the glue is completely dry, shake off the excess Powder on some unwanted paper. However, the Powder can still come off the Ground easily, so be careful in future assemblies and storage.



We will now assemble the Groves to the upper area of the Ground. First, insert the protrusion of ③ Grove B into the hole on the right.



Assemble ② Grove A in the same way.



Issue 11 Completed With the addition of the green Powder, the grassland background has a richer texture now. Any accidental rubbing or bumping could cause the Powder to come off, so please take extra care when storing it.
