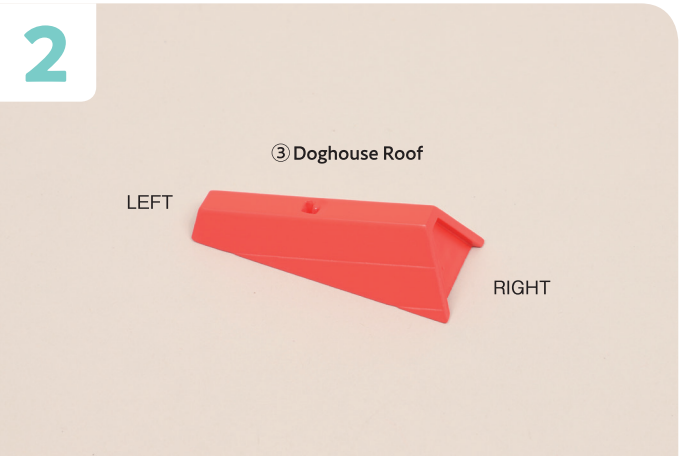

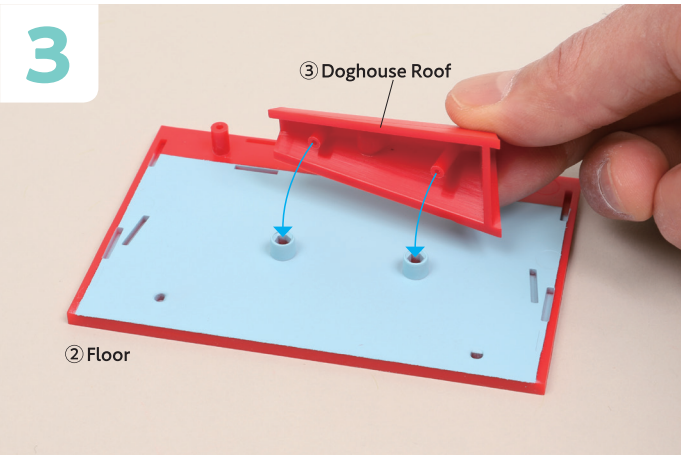
ASSEMBLING THE FLOOR AND OTHER PARTS



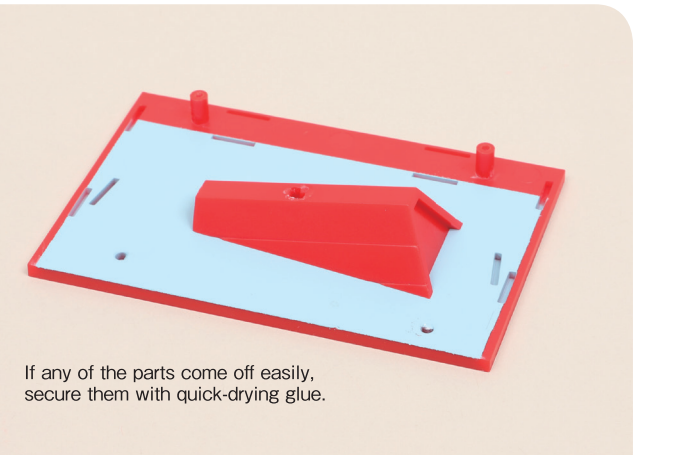
Check the orientation of the ② Floor with two protrusions at the center for the Doghouse Roof, and two holes on the left and right sides at the front for assembling the Clouds.



Make sure the ③ Doghouse Roof is facing the right way.

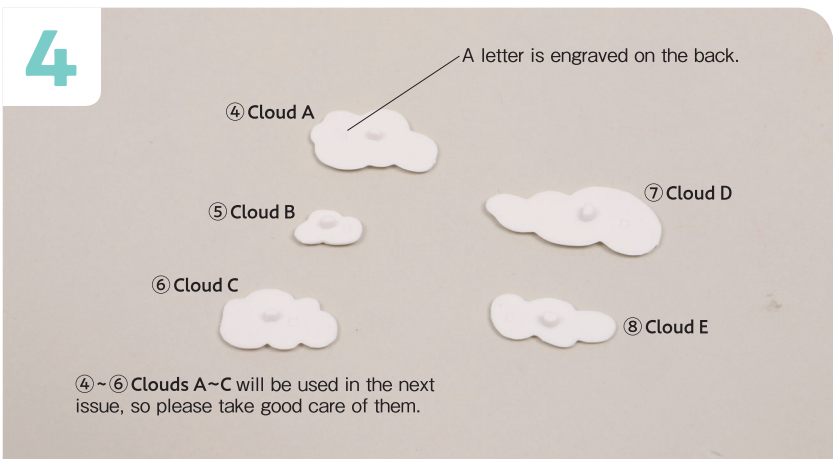


Insert the protrusions on the back of the ③ Doghouse Roof into the holes of the protrusions on the ② Floor.



If any of the parts come off easily, secure them with quick-drying glue.

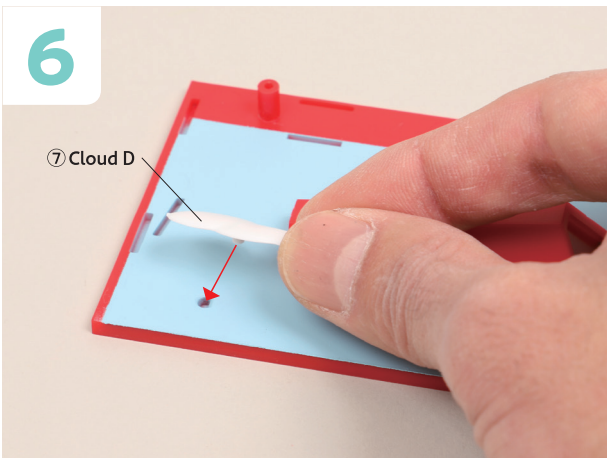
Assembling the Floor and Other Parts



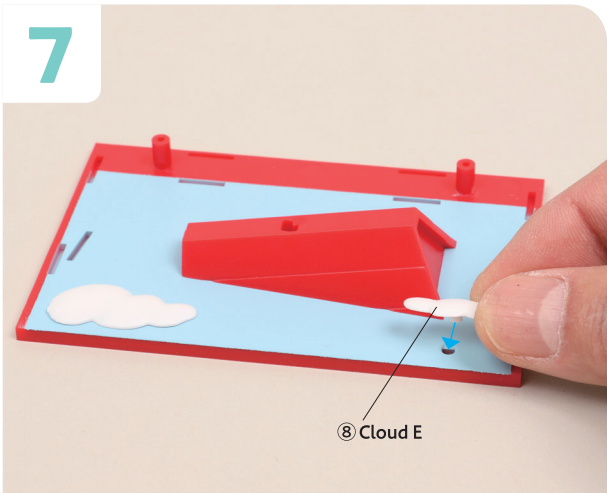
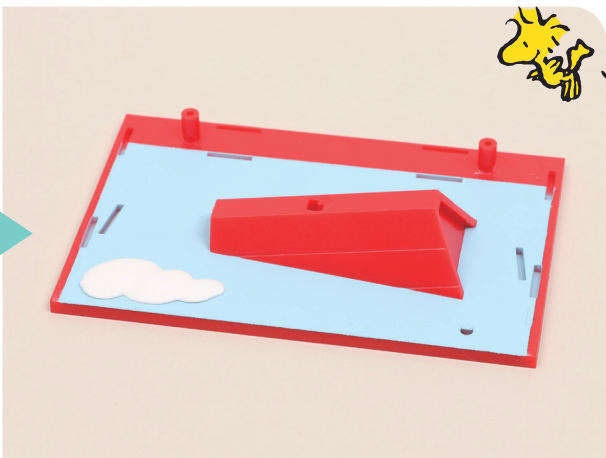
There are letters engraved on the backs (the side with a protrusion) of ④~⑧ Clouds A~E. We will use ⑦ Cloud D and ⑧ Cloud E in this issue. The rest will be used in the next issue, so please take good care of them.



The cross sections of the protrusions on the backs of ⑦ Cloud D and ⑧ Cloud E are D-shaped.



Assemble ⑦ Cloud D to the left front side of the Floor by inserting the protrusion on its back deep into the hole, matching the shapes of the protrusion and the hole.



Assemble ⑧ Cloud E to the right front side of the Floor in the same way.

Issue 14 Completed

That finishes the floor of the 【Flying Ace】 scene. ④~⑥ Clouds A~C will be assembled to the back wall in the next issue. The ⑨ Flowerpot will also be used in the next issue, so please take good care of them.

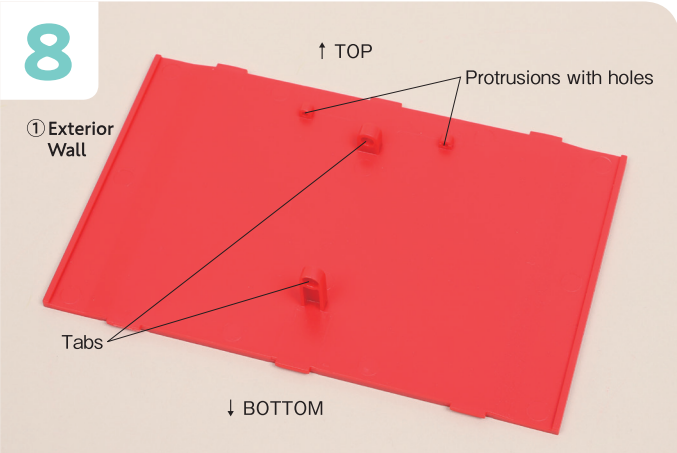

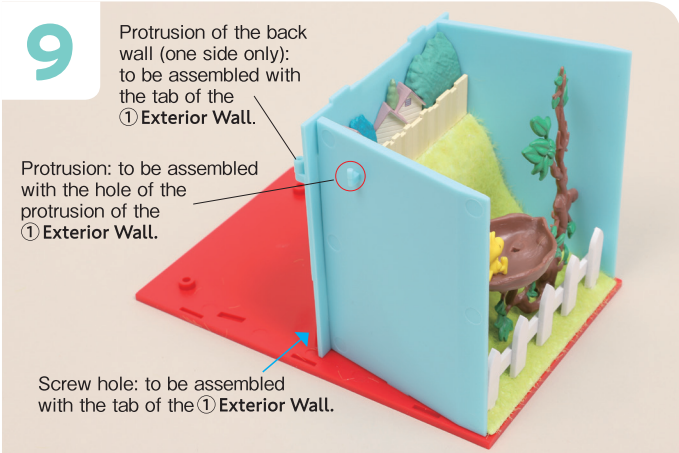




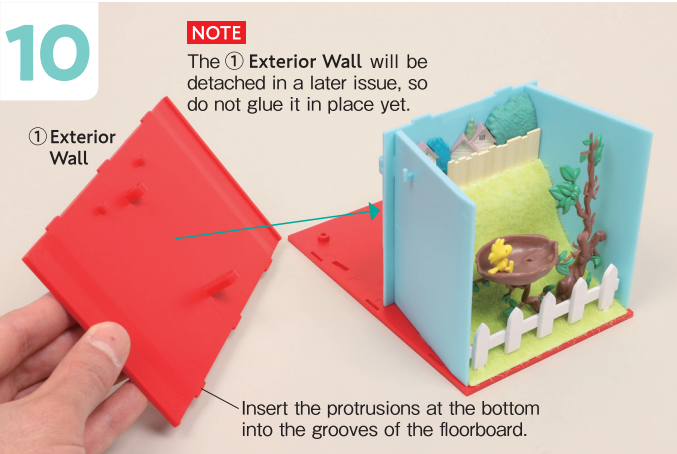
ASSEMBLING THE LEFT AND RIGHT EXTERIOR WALLS



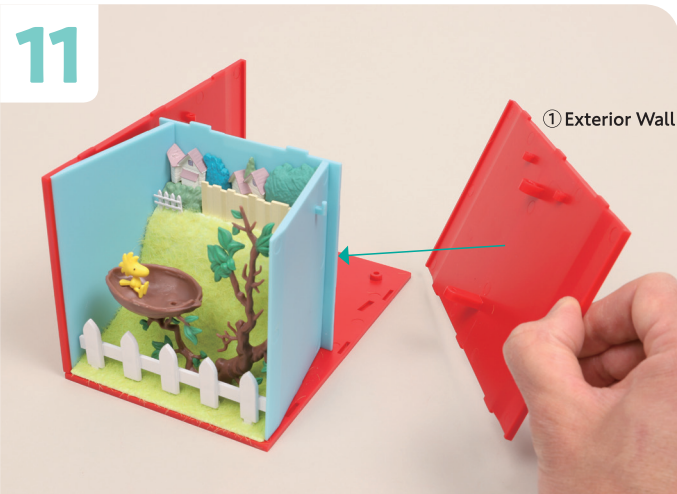
The ① Exterior Walls will be firmly fixed in place after they are completely assembled with the 【Football】 scene in a forthcoming issue. So, we will just assemble but not fix them in place for now. First, check the orientation of this ① Exterior Wall.



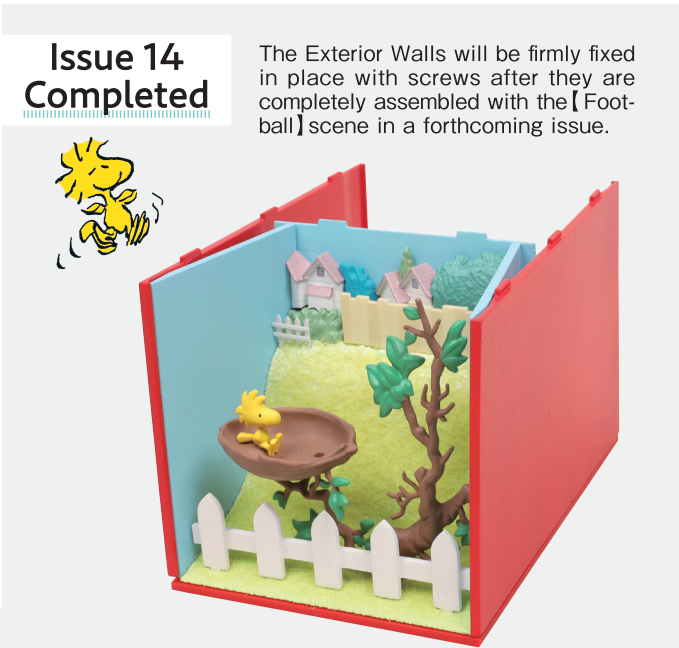
Get ready the 【Woodstock's Nest】 scene assembled in issue 13 and examine the wall. There is a protrusion on the wall (circled in red) and a screw hole on the back of the back wall (indicated by the blue arrow).



Assemble the ① Exterior Wall by aligning and fitting the protrusions and tabs.



Assemble the remaining ① Exterior Wall to the other side in the same way.



Let's display the figurine to have a look

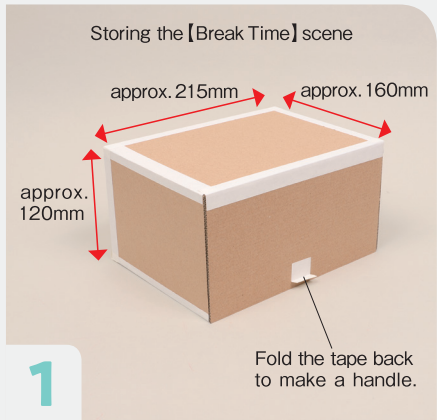


⑩ Snoopy is the figurine for the【Woodstock's Nest】scene. Insert the protrusion under the figurine into the hole of the nest and secure it with quick-drying glue.



Storing your scenes

Please store your assembled and partially-assembled scenes safely to avoid small parts getting lost or damaged. Many modellers like to keep their scenes on display but out of harm's way, such as on a bookshelf or in a cabinet. If you want to avoid dust accumulating, place your scene in an appropriately-sized box or under a plastic cover. You can also make a simple storage box from unused cardboard or thick paper, as shown here.



Cut cardboards or thick papers of approximately 160 x 120 mm, 120 x 215 mm and 160 x 215 mm in size, two sheets each for the 【Break Time】 scene.
