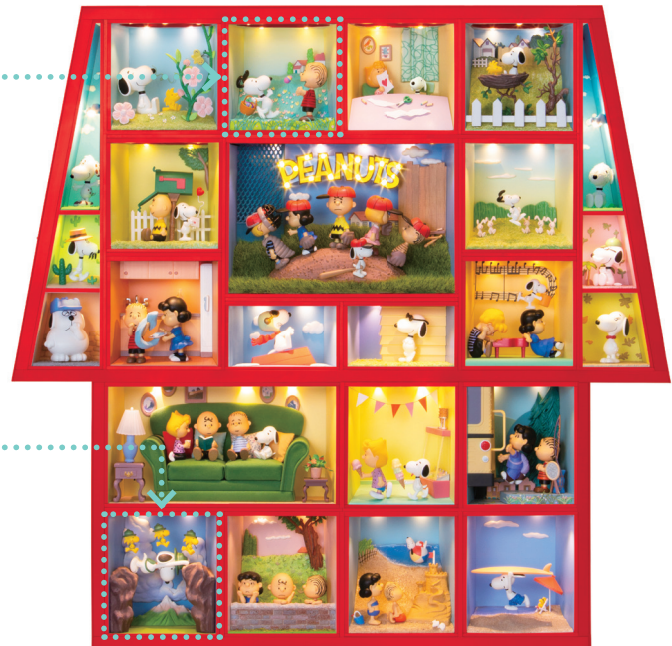

We will start assembling the 【Beagle Scouts】 scene in this issue. Begin by assembling a large Cloud as the background onto the Back Wall and then the surrounding walls to the Floorboard.

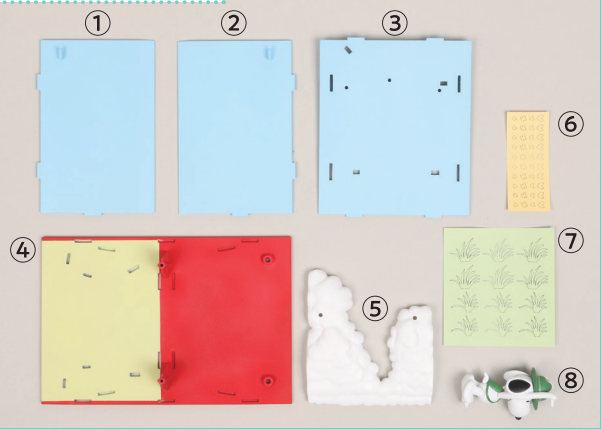

Making Grass and Flowers

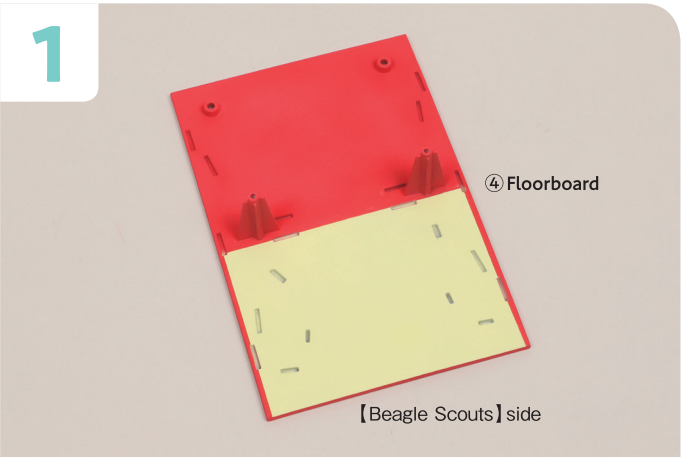

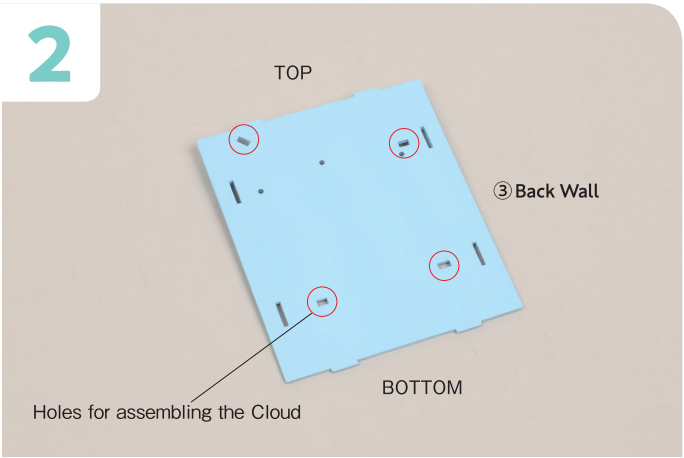

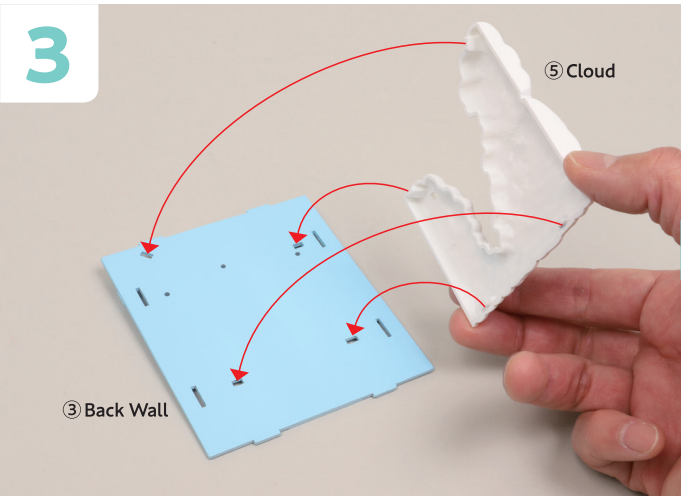
ASSEMBLING THE FLOORBOARD, BACK WALL, LEFT AND RIGHT WALLS



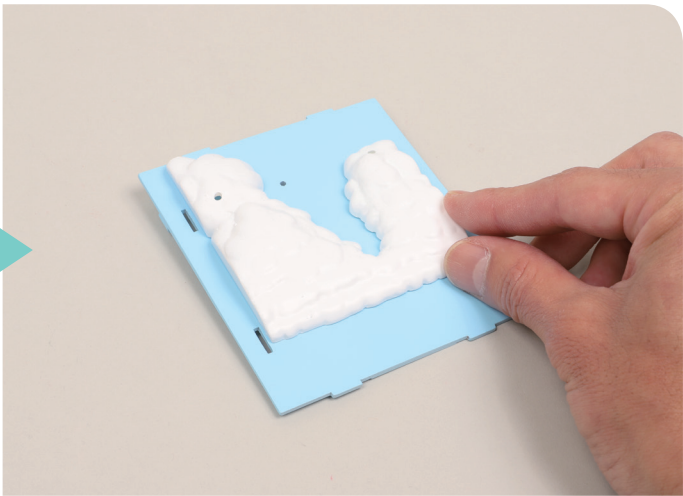
Check the orientation of the ④ Floorboard. The yellowish green side is for the 【Beagle Scouts】 scene.



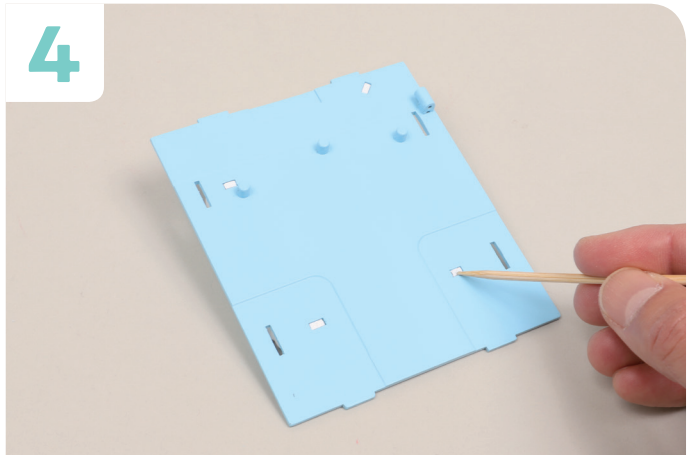
Check the orientation of the ③ Back Wall by referring to the holes for assembling the Cloud. Be careful not to mix up the top and bottom.



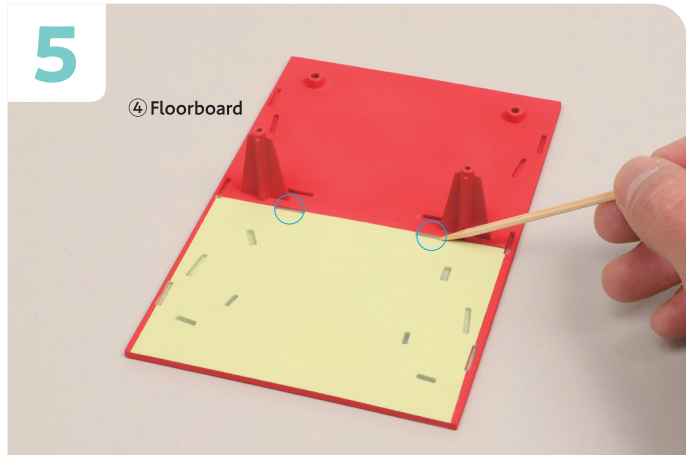
Assemble the ⑤ Cloud onto the ③ Back Wall by inserting its four protrusions into the holes on the wall.



Assembling the Floorboard, Back Wall, Left and Right Walls



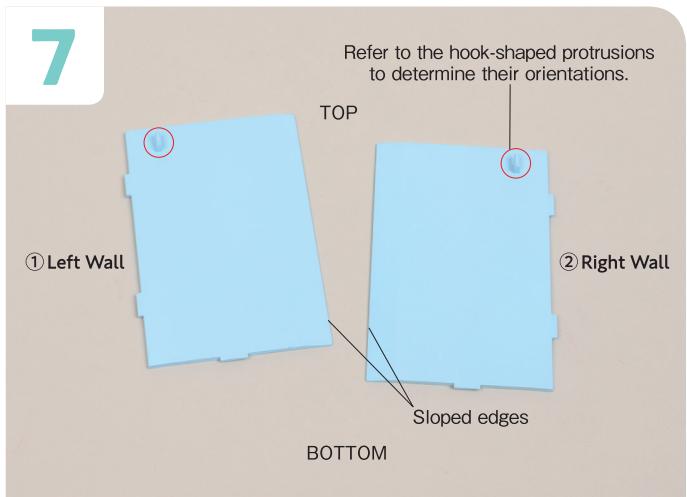
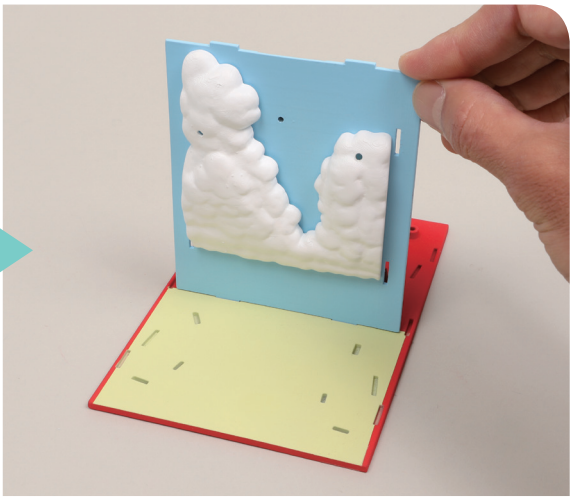
If the ⑤ Cloud tends to come off, apply quick-drying glue to the holes where the protrusions are inserted at the back of the wall to secure it in place.



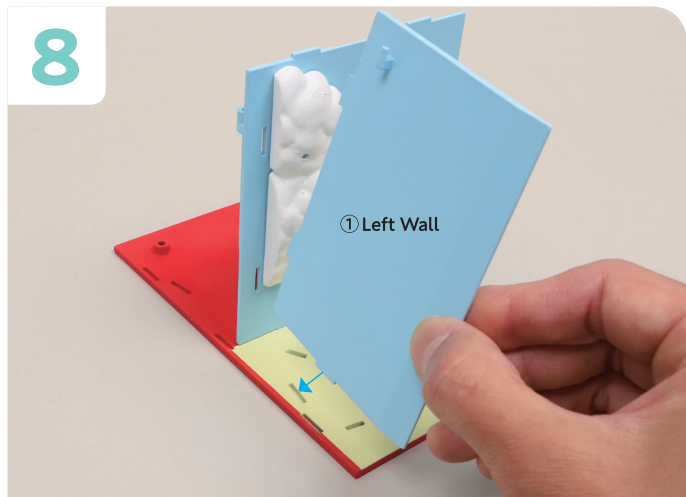
We will now assemble the Back Wall to the ④ Floorboard. First, apply quick-drying glue to the two grooves on the ④ Floorboard with a toothpick or the like.



Insert the protrusions under the Back Wall into the grooves on the Floorboard.



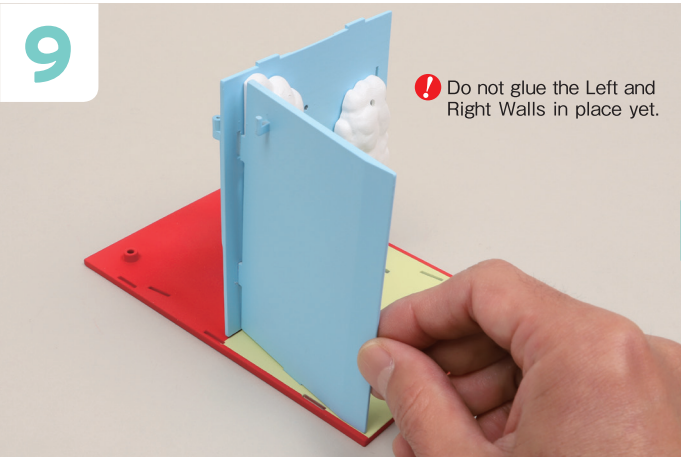
Check the orientations of the ① Left Wall and ② Right Wall.



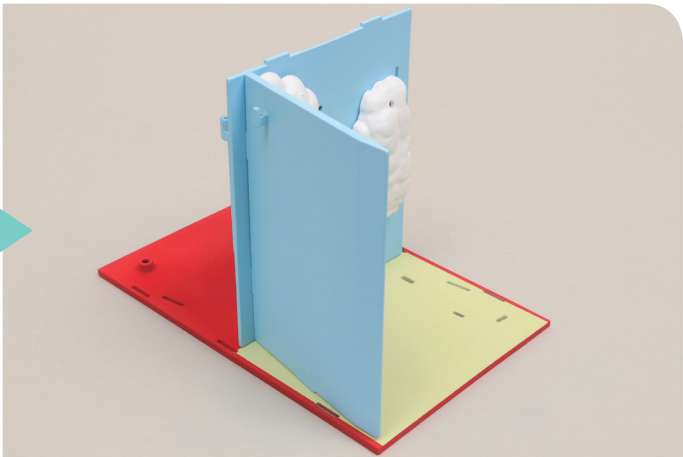
We will assemble the ① Left Wall to the Floorboard. First, insert the protrusion under the wall into the groove on the Floorboard.



Assembling the Floorboard, Back Wall, Left and Right Walls



Next, insert the protrusions at the back of the Left Wall into the holes on the Back Wall.



Assemble the ② Right Wall to the other side in the same way.

Making Grass and Flowers



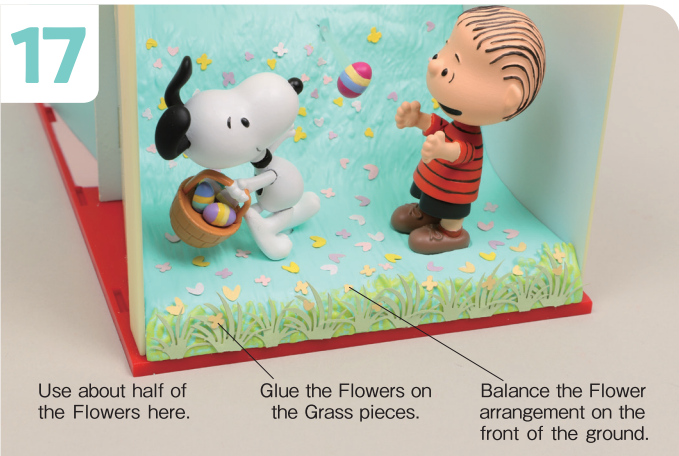
Grass B pieces have small leaves. You may trim them off to make some variations.



Glue Grass A and Grass B pieces to the front of the ground in the 【Easter】 scene. Starting from one end, align the bottom edges of the Grass pieces with the edge of the ground.

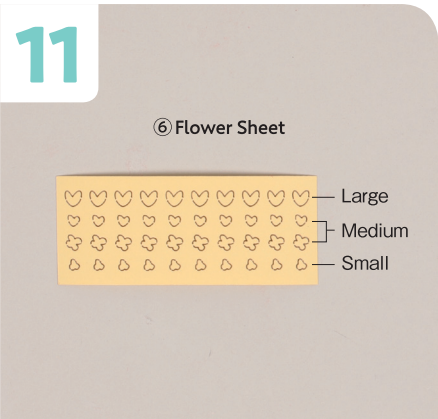


Glue Grass A and Grass B pieces onto it all the way to the other end. Overlap the neighboring Grass pieces a little. Try not to make too many of the same Grass type in a row by applying the pieces in a varied way.

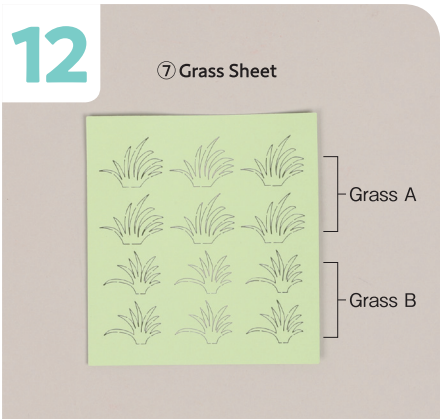


Glue the Flowers mainly to the front of the ground. Besides the front of the ground, glue some on the Grass pieces as well. About half of the Flowers will be used here.

MAKING GRASS AND FLOWERS



Check the ⑥ Flower Sheet: there are ten each of Flowers of different sizes and shapes on it.



The ⑦ Grass Sheet has six each of two Grass types of different shapes.



Use a cutter to cut and remove the Flowers and Grass from the joints of the ⑥ Flower Sheet and ⑦ Grass Sheet.



The remaining Flowers will be glued to other areas of the ground. In areas where there are fewer Flowers, balance the Flower arrangement to make it look more lively.
