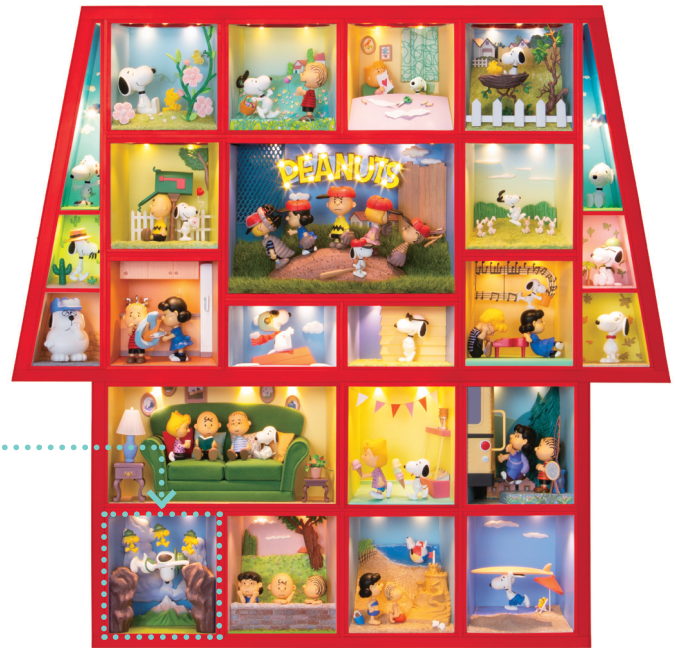

MOUNTAIN, ROCKS

We will complete the 【Beagle Scouts】 scene in this issue by adding the background Mountain and the Rocks to the Floorboard, placing the Snoopy figurine in between the Rocks and assembling the Beagle Scout figurines.



Led by Snoopy and comprising Woodstock and his friends, the Beagle Scouts enjoy the fun of outdoor adventures such as hiking and camping. But there are times when things can get dangerous and Scout Leader Snoopy must put himself on the line to keep his scouts safe. This scene is based on the comic strip from the Sunday, January 25th, 1981 edition in which Snoopy acts as a bridge to let the scouts cross, only to find himself unable to get back to his feet and having to spend the night alone.



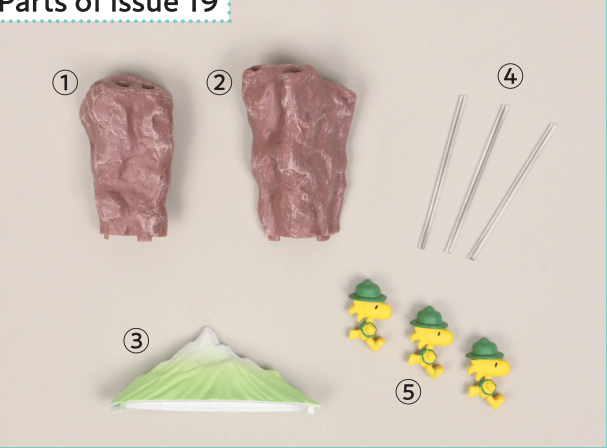
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembling the Mountain and Rocks

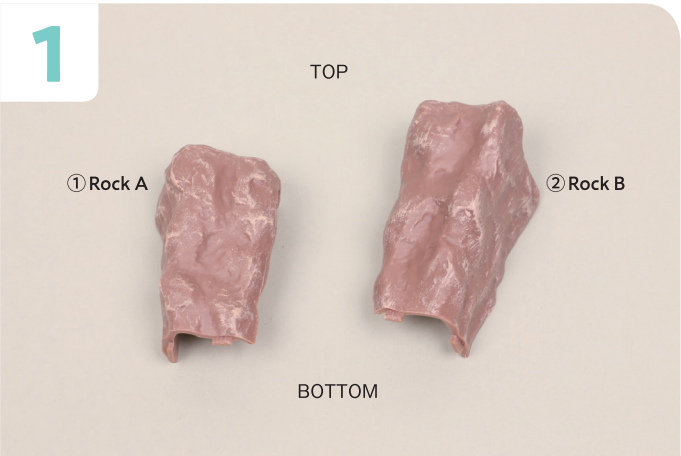
We will complete the 【Beagle Scouts】 scene in this issue by assembling the Mountain at the back of the Floorboard, the Rocks at the front, and the Snoopy figurine from issue 18 as well as the three Beagle Scout figurines.

① Rock A ② Rock B ③ Mountain ④ Pin×3 【Figurine】 ⑤ Beagle Scout×3

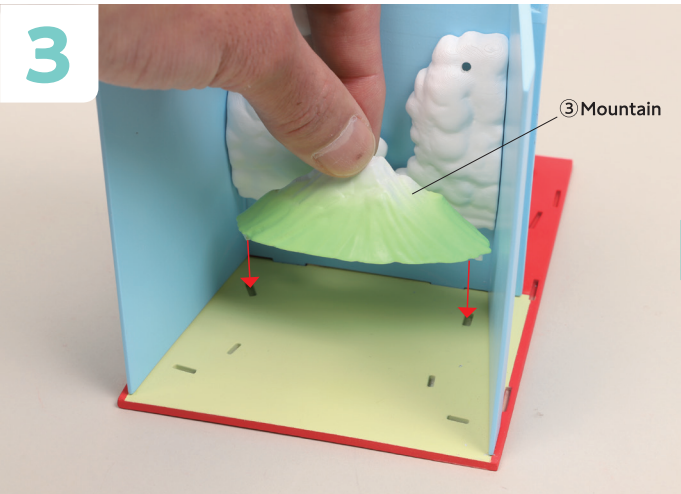
ASSEMBLING THE MOUNTAIN AND ROCKS



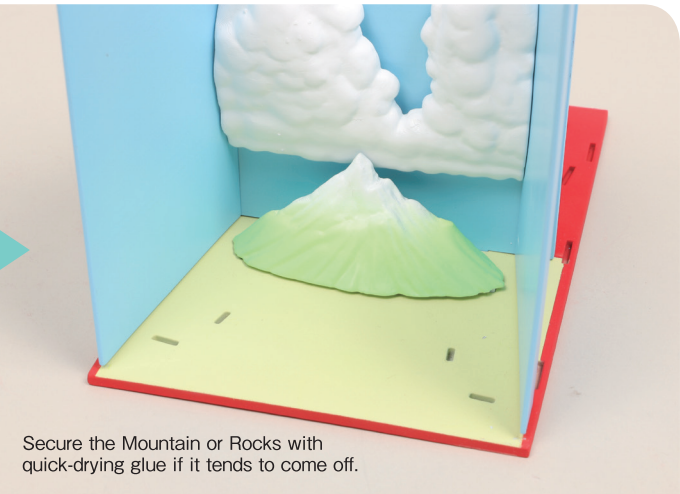
① Rock A and ② Rock B look similar, so be careful not to mix them up.



Check the orientation of the ③ Mountain by referring to the slope shapes and be careful not to mistake the left for the right.

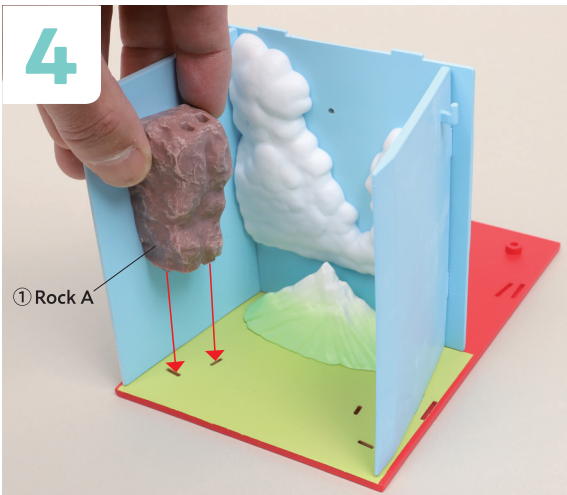


Assemble the ③ Mountain to the Floorboard assembled to the 【Beagle Scouts】 scene in Issue 18 by inserting its protrusions underneath into the holes at the back of the Floorboard.

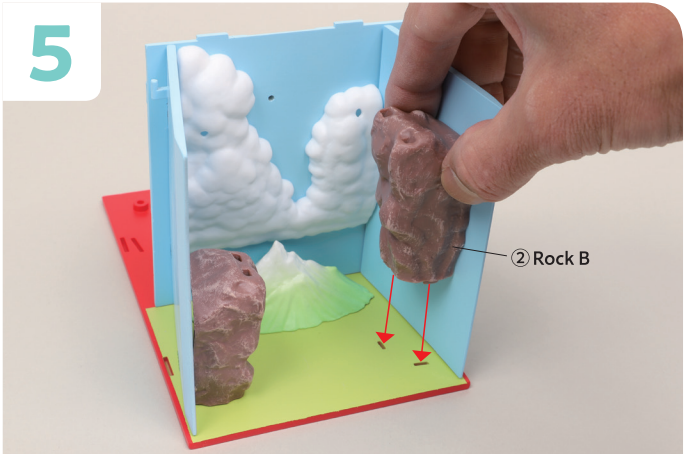


Secure the Mountain or Rocks with quick-drying glue if it tends to come off.

Assembling the Mountain and Rocks



Assemble ① Rock A to the left front of the Floorboard in the same way.



Then assemble ② Rock B to the right front of the Floorboard.

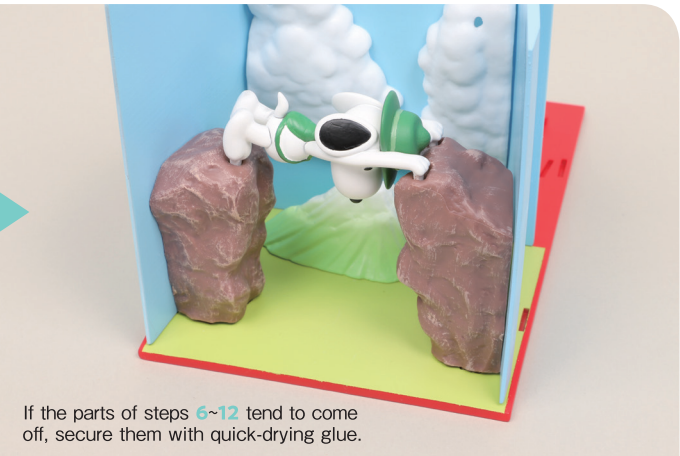
Now that the background and other elements of the 【Beagle Scouts】 scene have been assembled, let's go on to assembling the figurines.



ASSEMBLING THE FIGURINES



Assemble the Snoopy figurine from issue 18 by inserting his four protrusions into the holes on the Rocks.



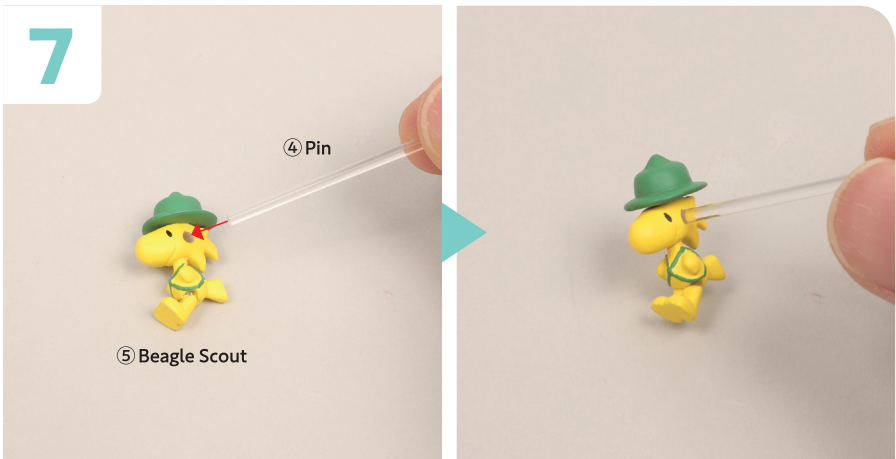
If the parts of steps 6~12 tend to come off, secure them with quick-drying glue.

Assembling the Figurines



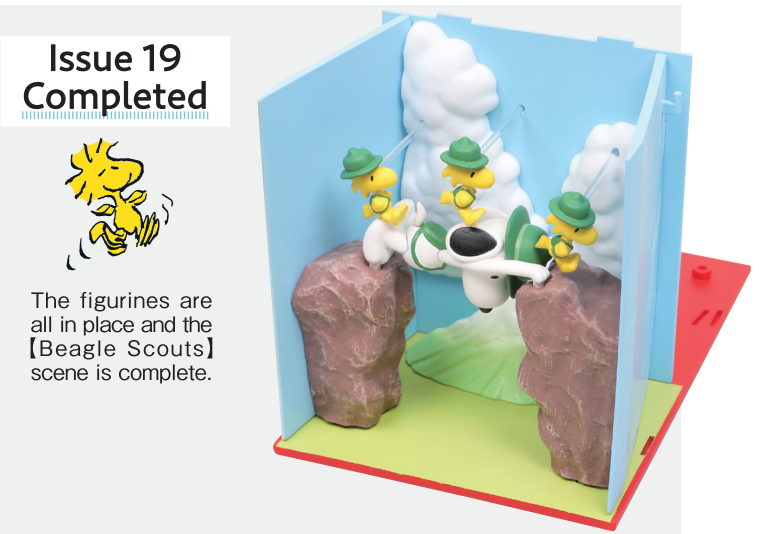
Insert one end of the (4) Pin into the hole of the (5) Beagle Scout.



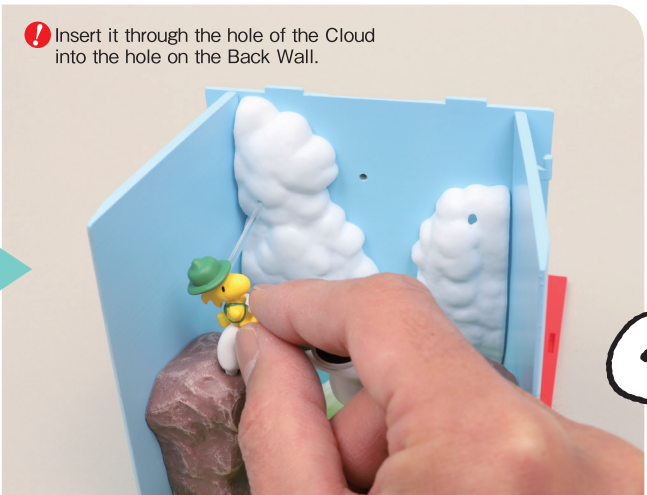
Assemble the remaining two (5) Beagle Scouts with one (4) Pin each in the same way.



Then assemble the remaining Beagle Scout figurine to the right of the Back Wall and adjust its position.



We will now assemble the Beagle Scout figurines to the scene. Insert the end of the Pin into the hole on the left of the Back Wall.



Adjust and confirm the orientation of the Beagle Scout figurine from the front.



Assemble the Beagle Scout figurine to the middle of the Back Wall and adjust its position as in steps 9~10.

For those who wish to enhance the texture of the Nest

We can enhance the texture of the inside of the Nest in the [Woodstock's Nest] scene by adding a few extra touches. No special tools or materials are required, all you need are some coloured pencil shavings.



Sharpen a dark brown coloured pencil and collect the shavings.



Rub the shavings with your fingertips to make them finer, especially the wood shavings.



Dissolve some wood glue thoroughly in water in a 1:1 ratio, add 2~3 drops of neutral detergent and apply it to the inside of the Nest. Be careful not to get it on the figurines.



Sprinkle the fine coloured pencil shavings evenly into the Nest, a little at a time so they do not spill out.
