GROUND, BEACH CHAIR

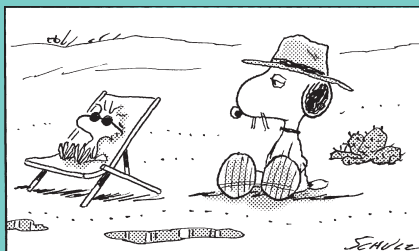
Let's start assembling the 【Surfboard/Figure Skating】 scene. Glue the sheet that imitates the sea surface onto the Ground of the 【Surfboard】 scene and cover the Ground with Sand to make it look like a real sandy beach.

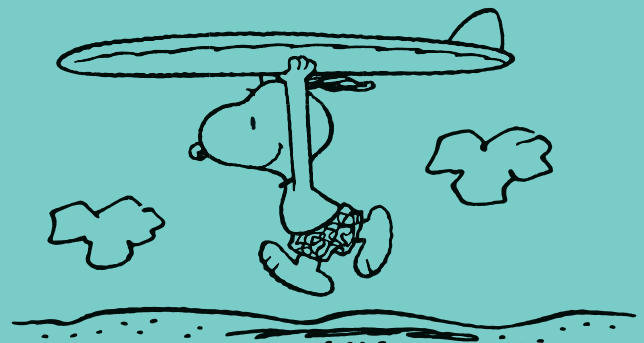

Making the Ground and Beach Chair

Let's start assembling the 【Surfboard/Figure Skating】 scene. First, cover the Ground of the 【Surfboard】 scene with Sand to make it look more realistic, then decorate it with a Beach Chair.

④ Sand



We will use about half of it in this issue.



The rest will be used in a later issue, so please keep it safe in the bag.

6

Add 2~3 drops of neutral detergent to the glue and mix well. Unlike when we worked with the Powder, there is no need to add water here.



We will use about half of the ④ Sand in this issue. Pour out the amount required on a palette or the like.

To glue the Sand to the Ground, we need to use wood glue. Squeeze out about a quarter teaspoon of glue on a palette, add 2~3 drops of neutral detergent and mix well. The detergent can also be replaced with soapy water.

MAKING THE GROUND AND BEACH CHAIR

1

Dot some quick-drying glue along the perimeter.

② Sea Sheet

This non-glossy side is the back.

Let's glue the ② Sea Sheet to the Ground. First, apply quick-drying glue along the perimeter at the back with the tip of a toothpick or the like.

② Sea Sheet

③ Ground

Align and assemble the ② Sea Sheet with the indentation of the ③ Ground.

Trim off about 2mm of the tip.

We will need three pieces of it.

We can insert toothpicks into the holes on the Ground so they will not be clogged up by the Sand we sprinkle. First, get a toothpick and cut it into three pieces of approximately 2cm sticks as shown above.

Do not glue the toothpicks in place as they will be removed later.

Insert the toothpicks cut in step 3 into the holes on the Ground. Do not glue them in place as they will be removed later.

Also apply glue to where it meets the Sea Sheet.



Make sure to clean the used paintbrush well before the glue dries.

Also apply glue to where the beach meets the Sea Sheet.

Sprinkle the Sand a little at a time.

Place the Ground on some unwanted paper and sprinkle the Sand prepared in step 5 on the beach area. Rub to loosen the Sand with fingertips and sprinkle a little at a time.

It is best to sprinkle just enough to slightly expose the Ground terrain. You can sprinkle a little more Sand here.

After sprinkling the Sand, leave it for a few hours to allow the glue to dry completely.

Sprinkle the Sand evenly and instead of covering the Ground completely as with the Powder, it is best to sprinkle just enough to slightly expose the Ground terrain.



Adding "Matte Medium" can reduce the gloss of the glue

Wood glue leaves a gloss finish when it dries. To reduce the gloss, we can mix in a few drops of "Matte Medium". The photo below shows Turner's "Matte Medium" but you can use a similar product from any other maker.

Take some glue from step 6 with a paintbrush and apply it to the beach area of the Ground.

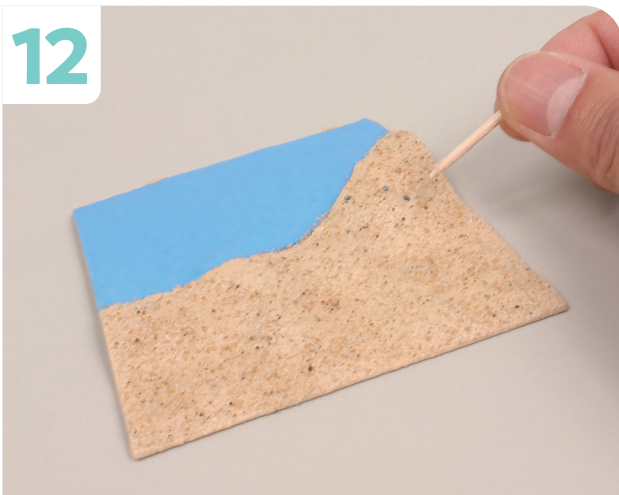

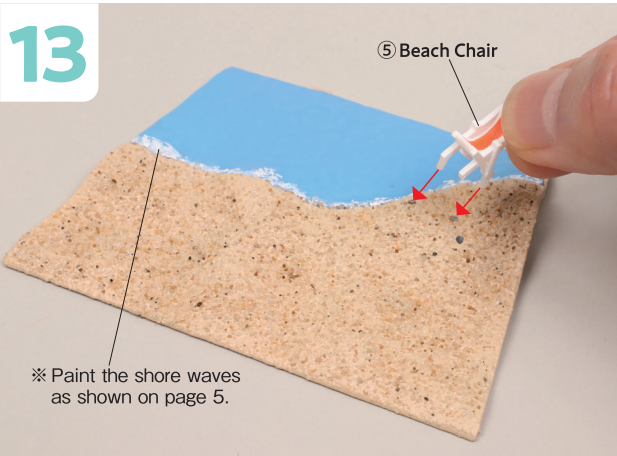


Any rubbing could cause the Sand to come off, so please take extra care when you assemble and store it.

After the glue is completely dry, gently shake off the excess Sand on some unwanted paper. Any rubbing could cause the Sand to come off, so please take extra care when you assemble and store it.



Remove the toothpick inserted into the Ground in step 4.



Assemble the 5 Beach Chair by inserting the two protrusions at its leg ends into the holes on the Ground. If it tends to come off, apply a little quick-drying glue to secure it in place.

With the sheet that imitates the sea surface and Sand added to the Ground, a realistic beach is now complete.



Adding the figurine

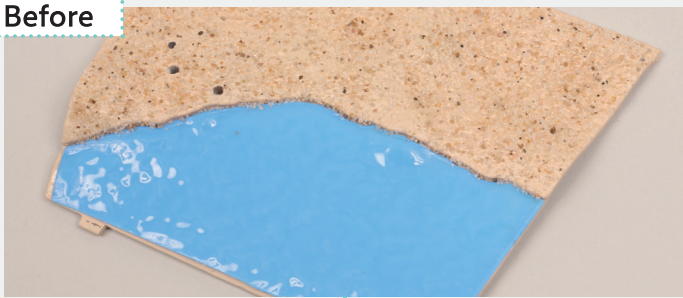
We can now place 6 Woodstock on the Beach Chair. Use double-sided tape or a little quick-drying glue to secure him in place.



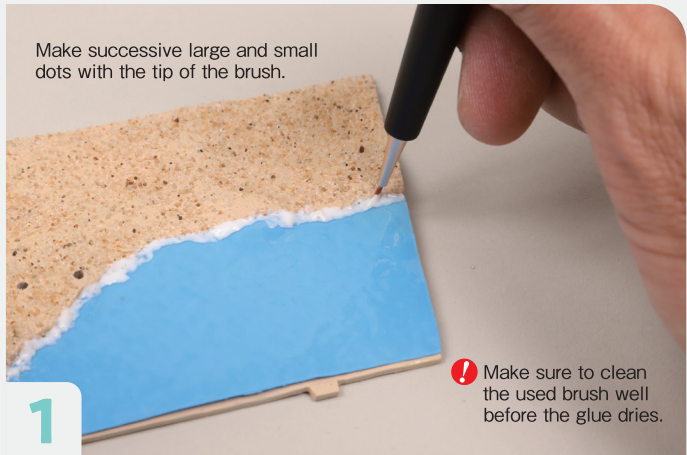
For those who wish to make it look even more realistic by adding extra touches of shore waves

The beach looks realistic as it is, but we can make it look even more lifelike by working on the shore waves. Apply wood glue to where the sea meets the beach, then apply white paint to depict the bubbles from the waves lapping against the shore.

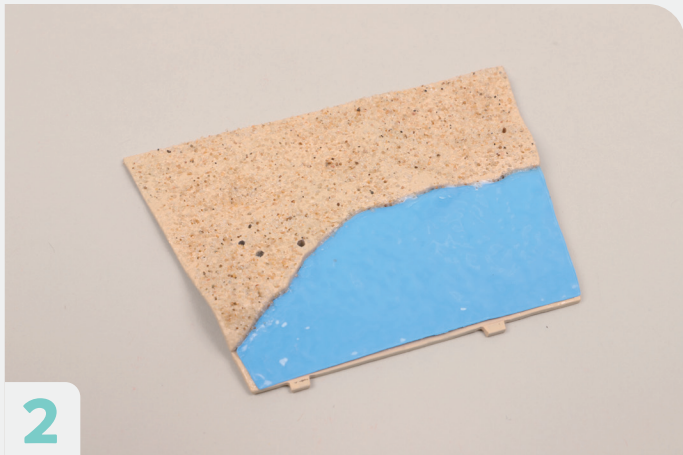

Make sure to clean the used brush well before the glue dries.

First, make the meeting point of the sea and the beach more natural, that is to smooth out the meeting point so the bumps and gaps are less visible. Take some glue with a liner brush to bring the meeting point slightly closer to the sea, better with subtle, varying degrees of intensity.

Allow the glue to dry completely. When the glue dries, it becomes transparent and slightly shrinks, you may apply glue again if necessary.

Now let's depict the bubbles from the waves lapping against the shore. First, squeeze out white paint on a palette, dissolve it in about five times the amount of water, add a few drops of neutral detergent and mix well.

Apply the paint to the meeting point of the sea and the beach with a liner brush, and a bit to the sea. Hold the brush vertically and make large and small dots with its tip.
