FLOORBOARD, BACK WALL, LEFT AND RIGHT WALLS, GROUND, BUILDING

We will assemble the 【Figurine Box, Joe Cool】 scene. Simply assemble the surrounding walls to the Floorboard and add the Ground and Building to complete the scene.

Snoopy dons a pair of sunglasses to become Joe Cool, one of his famous alter egos. After first appearing in the 27th May 1971 strip, shown below, Joe Cool quickly became a classic PEANUTS character.

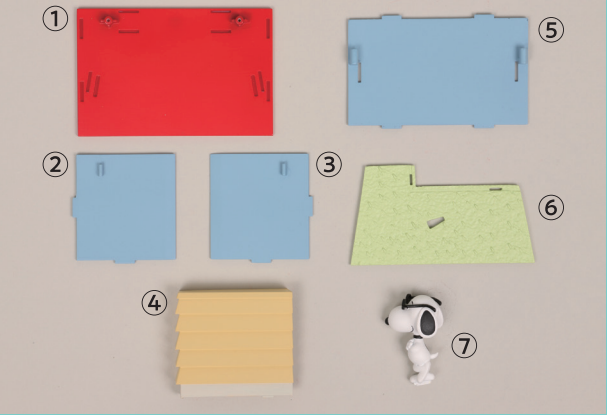

Assembling the Floorboard, Back Wall, Left and Right Walls, Ground and Building

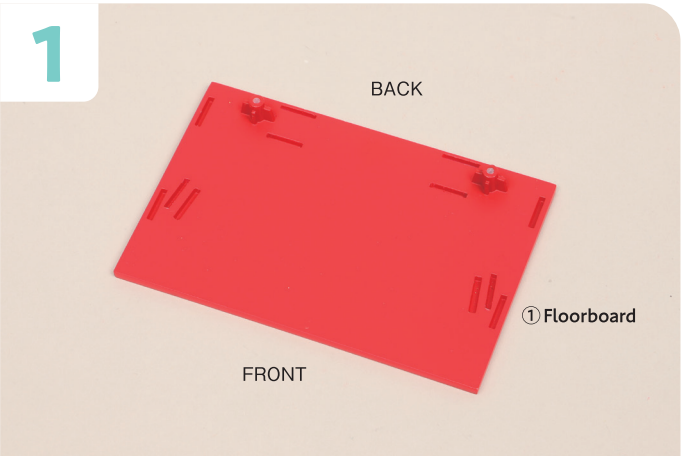
We will assemble the 【Figurine Box, Joe Cool】 scene in this issue. Let's assemble the surrounding walls to the Floorboard and add the Ground and Building to complete the scene.

- ① Floorboard ② Left Wall ③ Right Wall ④ Building ⑤ Back Wall ⑥ Ground 【Figurine】 ⑦ Joe Cool

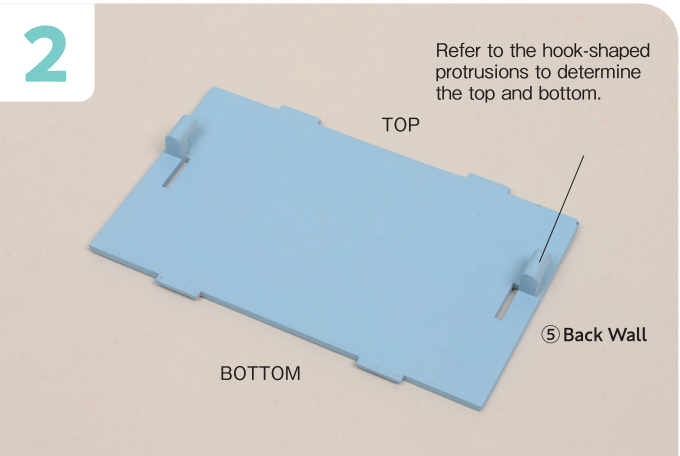

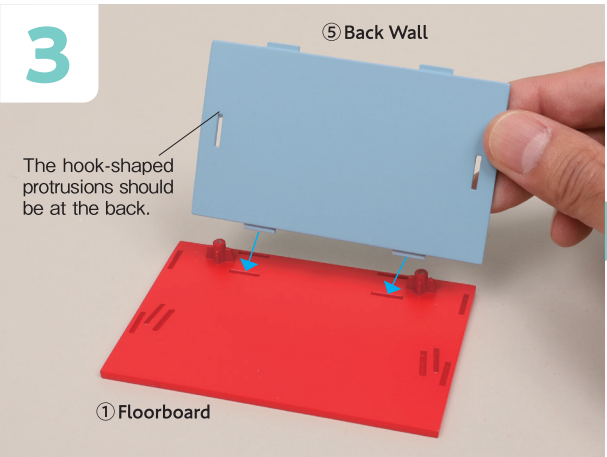
ASSEMBLING THE FLOORBOARD, BACK WALL, LEFT & RIGHT WALLS



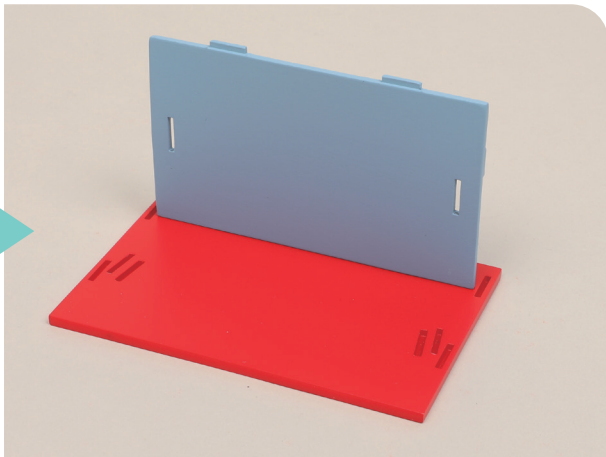
Check the orientation of the ① Floorboard. Refer to the grooves and protrusions to determine the correct direction.



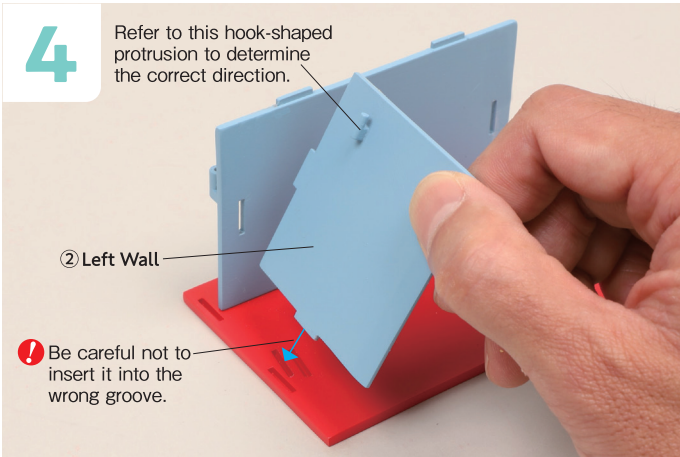
Also check the orientation of the ⑤ Back Wall - be careful not to mistake the top and bottom.



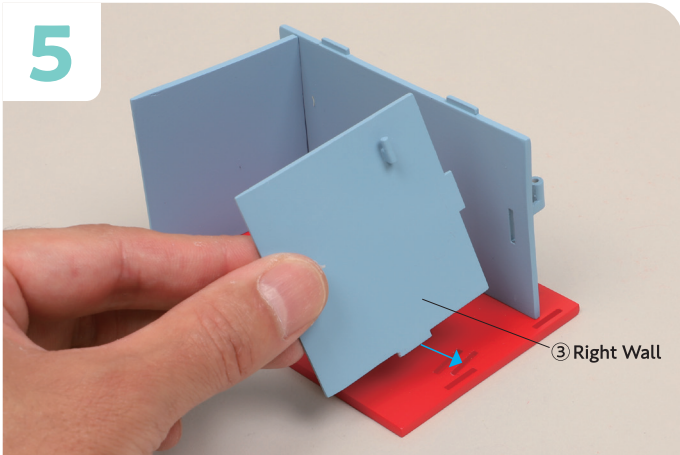
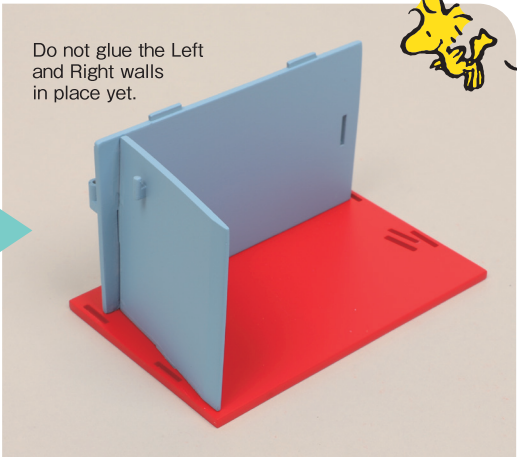
Apply quick-drying glue to the grooves of the ① Floorboard and assemble the ⑤ Back Wall as before.



Assembling the Floorboard, Back Wall, Left and Right Walls



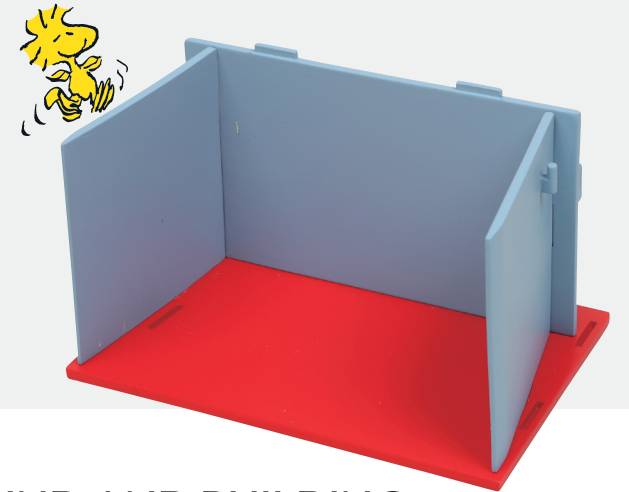
Assemble the ② Left Wall to the Floorboard in the same way.



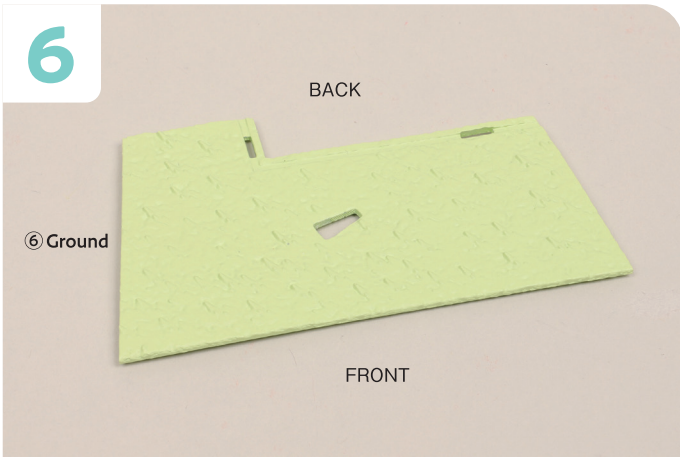
Then assemble the ③ Right Wall.

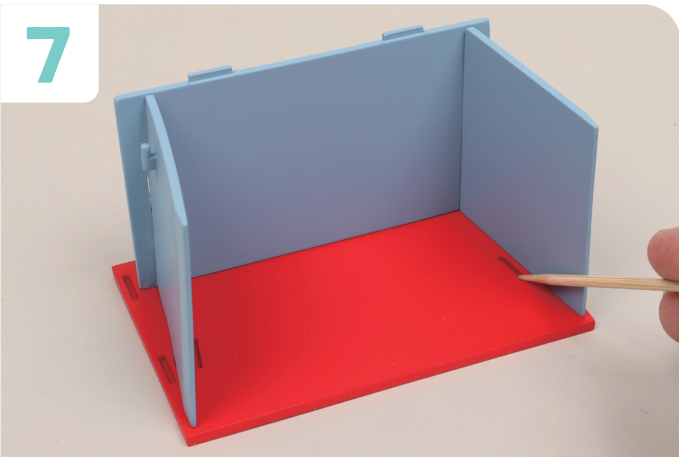
With the surrounding walls fitted to the 【Figurine Box, Joe Cool】 scene, we can now assemble the Ground and Building.



ASSEMBLING THE GROUND AND BUILDING



Check the orientation of the ⑥ Ground.



Apply a little quick-drying glue to the grooves on the left and right sides of the Floorboard with the tip of a toothpick or the like.

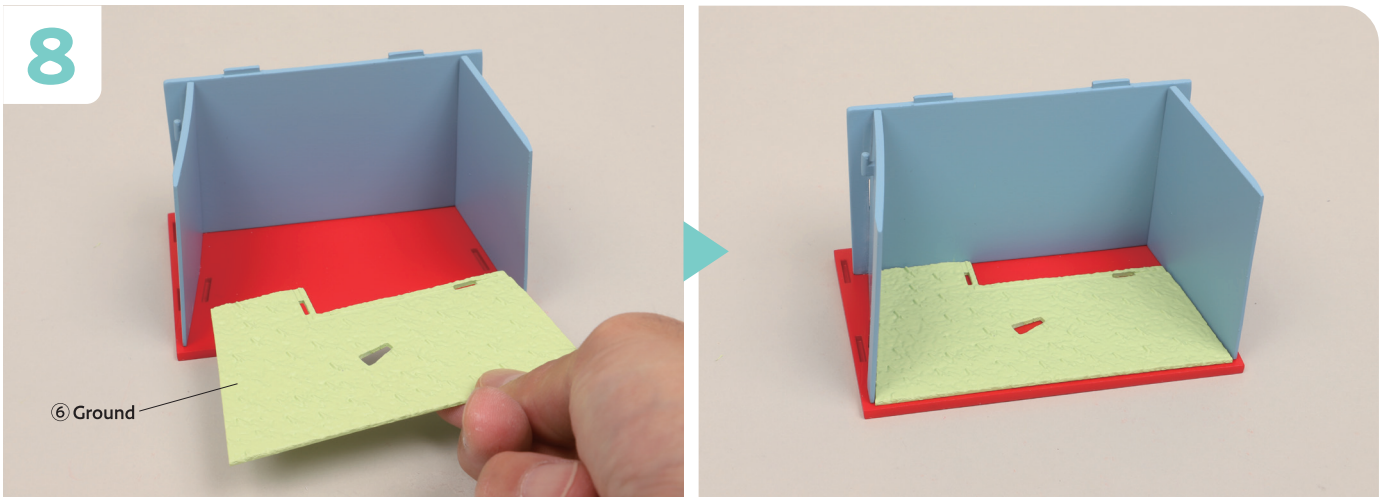

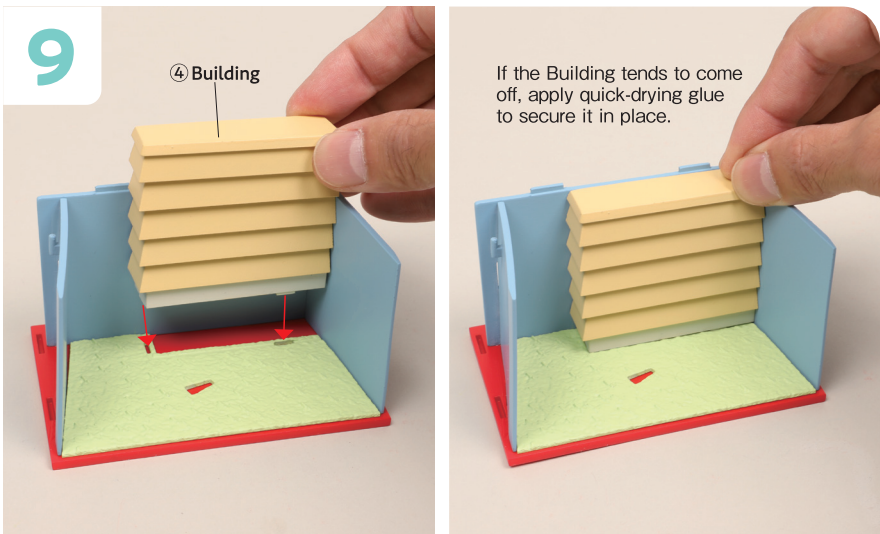

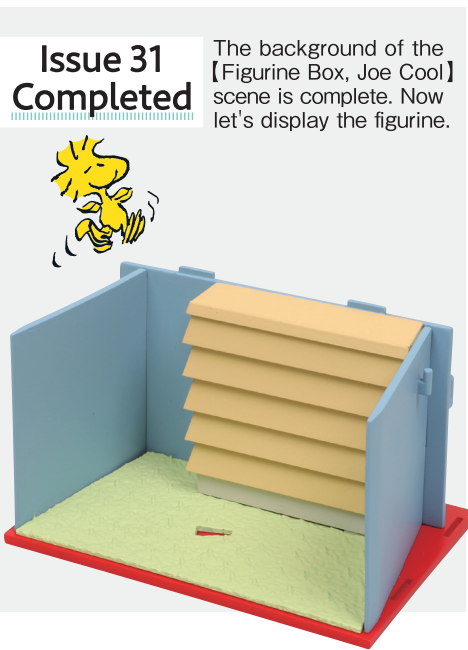
Assembling the Ground and Building



Before the glue dries, assemble the ⑥ Ground to the Floorboard by inserting the two protrusions at its back into the holes in the Floorboard.

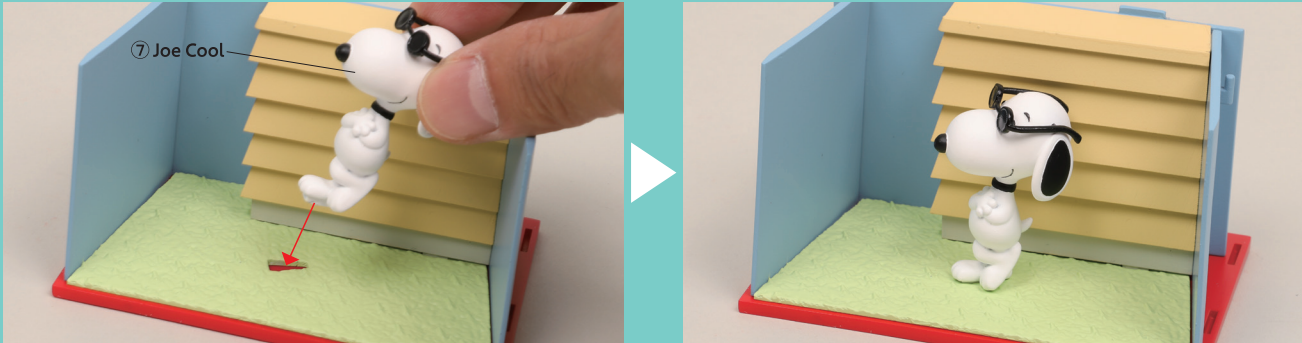


Then assemble the ④ Building to the Ground by inserting its two protrusions into the holes in the Ground. If it tends to come off, apply quick-drying glue to secure it in place.



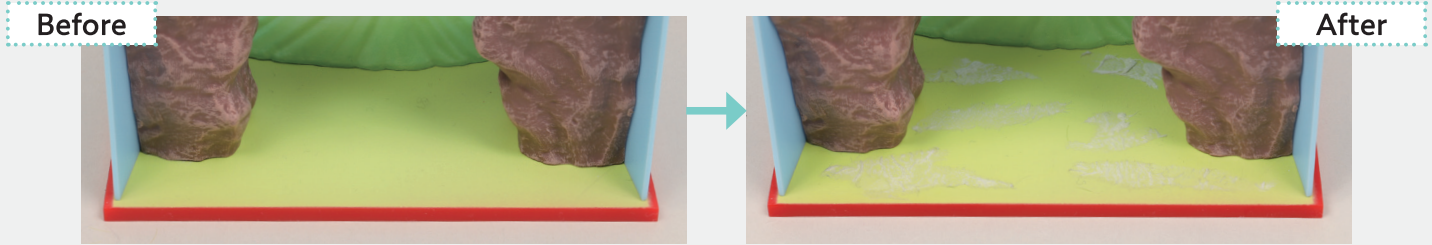
Adding the figurine

Let's display the ⑦ Joe Cool figurine. Apply quick-drying glue to the protrusion under his foot and insert it into the hole in the Ground.



Adding a Sea of Clouds to the [Beagle Scouts] scene

In the [Beagle Scouts] scene Snoopy acts as a bridge between two towering mountain peaks. The scene is complete as supplied but for those who like to add extra details, it is easy to introduce a sea of clouds to enhance the feeling of elevation. All you need is some regular tissue paper.



1 Peel off one ply of tissue paper and tear it into small pieces in the direction of its fibre.

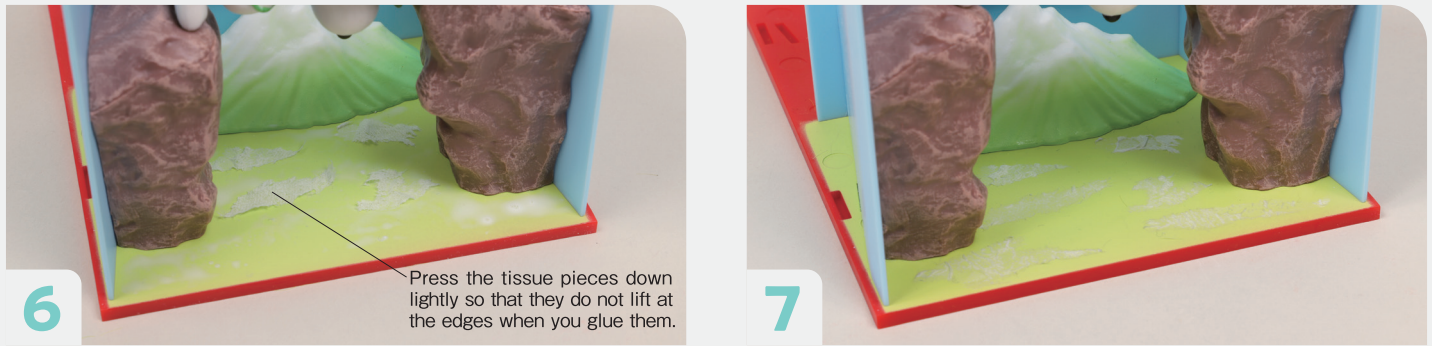
2 Prepare tissue pieces of different shapes and sizes, ranging from 1~3 cm long.

3 Dissolve wood glue in water in a 1:1 ratio, add 2~3 drops of neutral detergent and mix well.



4 Apply the glue to the Floorboard of the [Beagle Scouts] scene with a paintbrush. Be careful not to get the glue on the Mountains or Rocks.

5 Glue the torn tissue pieces to the Floorboard. Start with the smaller ones and from the back.



6 Glue them from the back to the front in the same way, in a well-balanced manner. The closer to the front, the larger the tissue piece should be.

7 Glue some larger tissue pieces to the front. With a good balance of large and small pieces, a sense of perspective is created.
