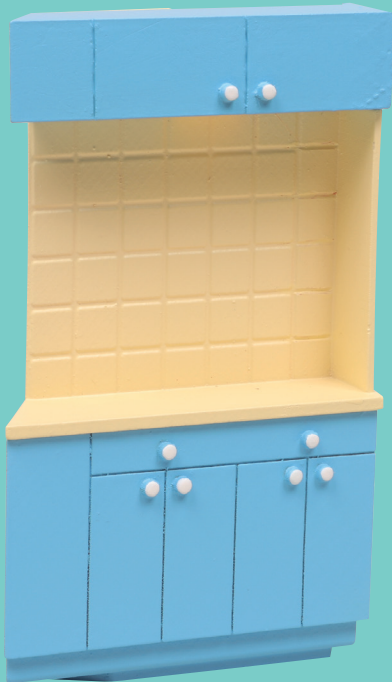

KITCHEN CABINETS

We will assemble the Kitchen Cabinets to be placed in the 【Eating Together】 scene by fitting the Upper and Base Cabinets to the Back Panel.

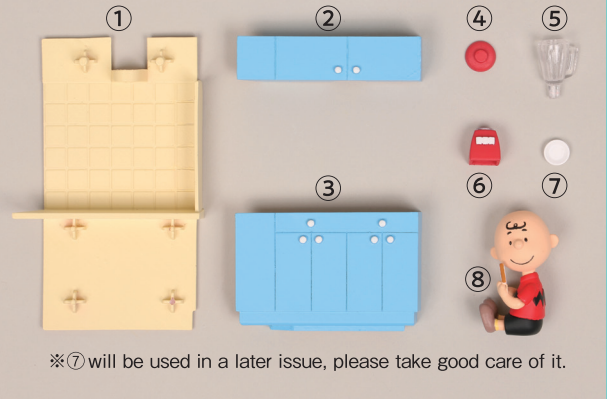
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

【Break Time, Eating Together】

Assembling the Kitchen Cabinets and Blender

We will assemble the Kitchen Cabinets to be placed on the left of the 【Eating Together】 scene by fitting the Upper and Base Cabinets to the Back Panel. We will also make the Blender to be displayed on the Kitchen Base Cabinet.

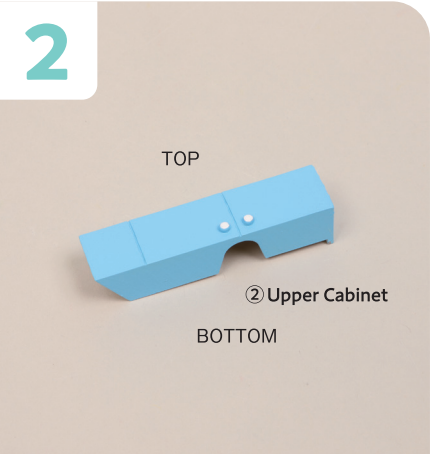


- ① Back Panel ② Upper Cabinet ③ Base Cabinet ④ Lid ⑤ Container
- ⑥ Main Body ⑦ Bowl 【Figurine】 ⑧ Charlie Brown

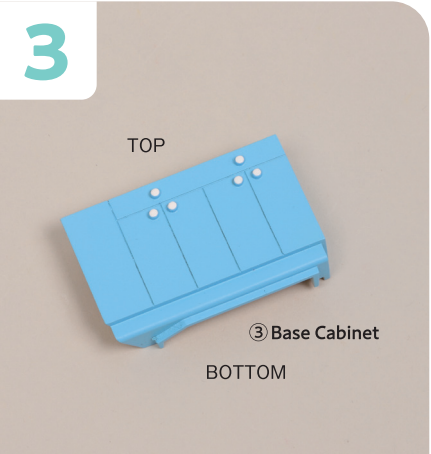
ASSEMBLING THE KITCHEN CABINETS



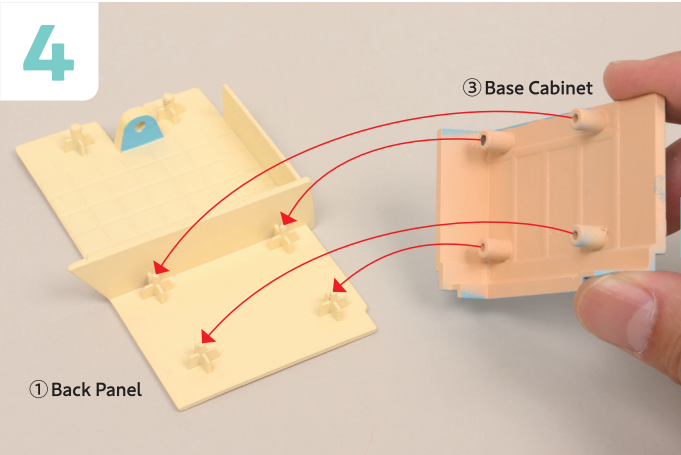
Check the orientation of the ① Back Panel and be careful not to mistake the top and bottom.



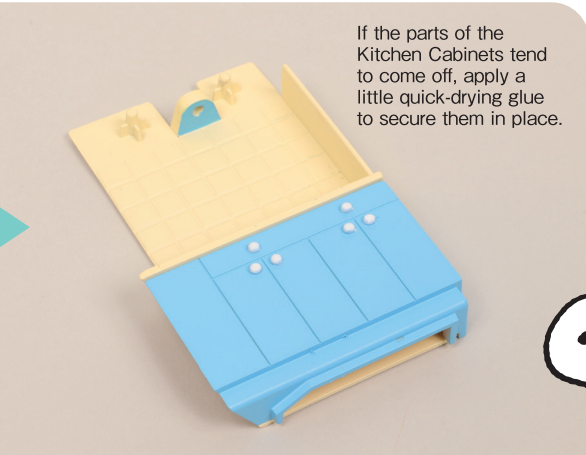
Also check the orientation of the ② Upper Cabinet.



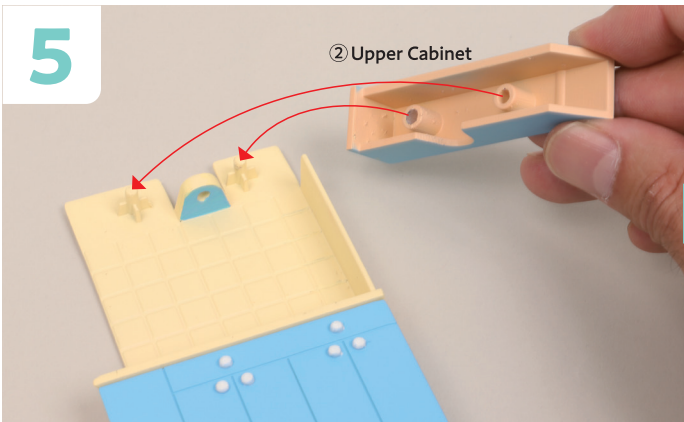
Check the orientation of the ③ Base Cabinet as well.



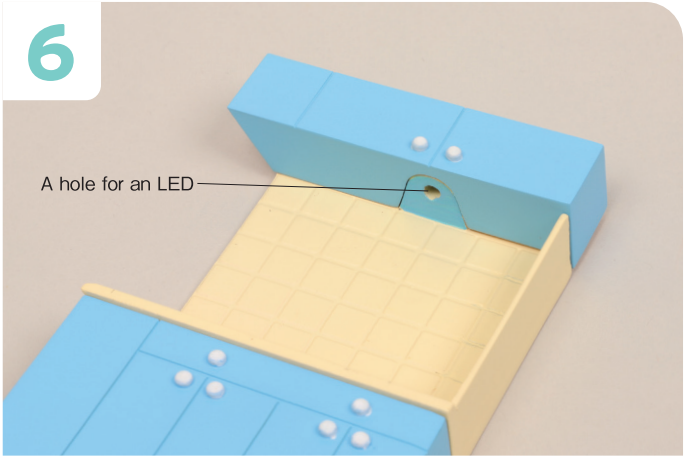
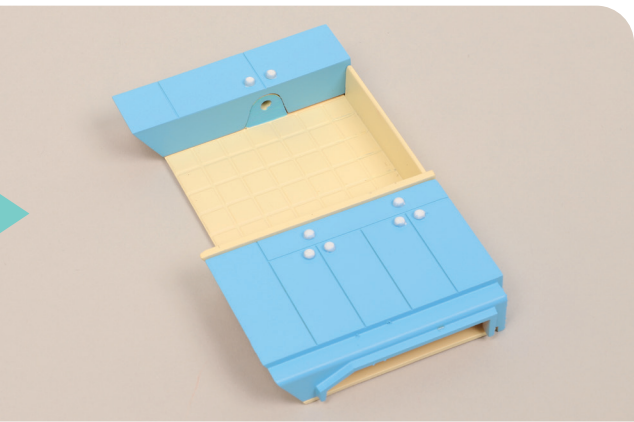
Now assemble the ③ Base Cabinet to the ① Back Panel by inserting the Back Panel's protrusions all the way into the holes at the back of the cabinet.



Assembling the Kitchen Cabinets



Assemble the ② Upper Cabinet to the upper side of the Back Panel in the same way.



There is a hole under the ② Upper Cabinet. An LED will be fitted into this hole in a later issue.

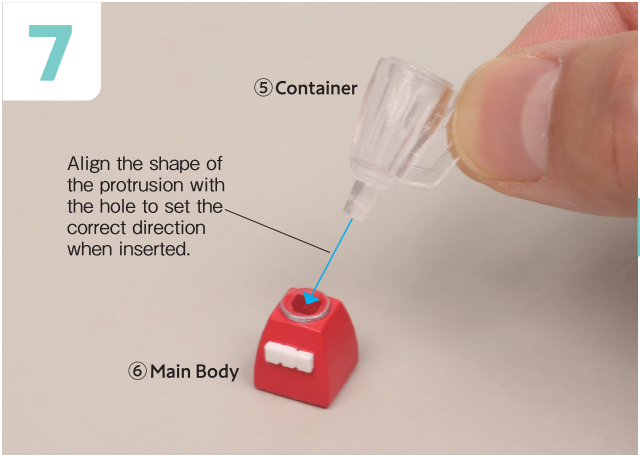
Issue 35 Completed



The Kitchen Cabinets for the 【Eating Together】 scene is now complete. Let's move on to make the Blender.



ASSEMBLING THE BLENDER



Assemble the ⑤ Container to the ⑥ Main Body. Align the shape of its protrusion with the hole of the Main Body to insert it.

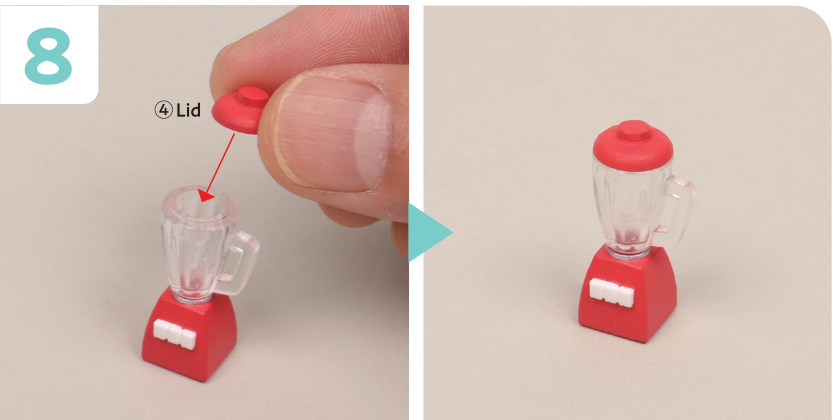


If it tends to come off, apply a little quick-drying glue to secure it in place.





Assembling the Blender



Fit the ④ Lid to the top of the Container. If it tends to come off, apply a little quick-drying glue to secure it in place.



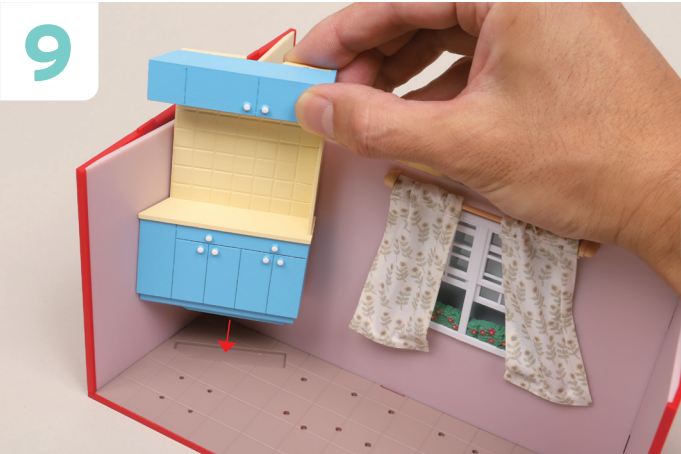
Displaying the furniture and other items



Now display the Blender on the Kitchen Base Cabinet. Apply double-sided tape to its bottom and display it on the right side on the Kitchen Base Cabinet as shown.



DISPLAYING THE FURNITURE AND OTHER ITEMS



The Kitchen Cabinets should be displayed on the left of the 【Eating Together】 scene. Insert the protrusion underneath into the hole in the floor.



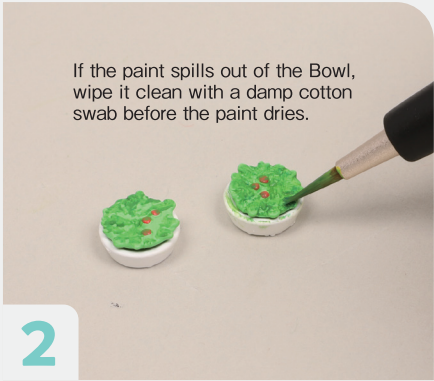
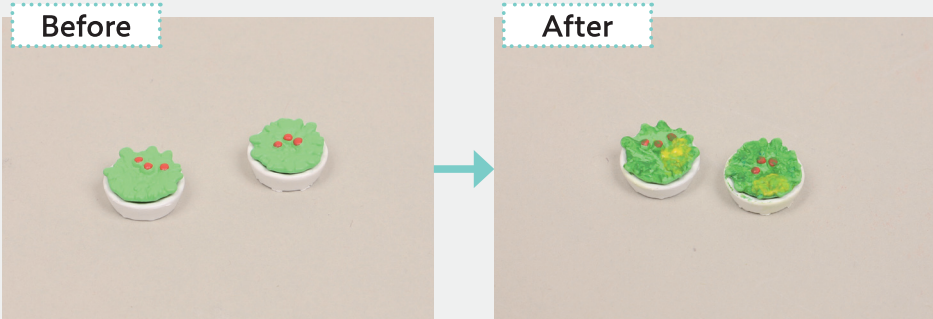
Set the three Chairs with their legs fitted into the holes in the floor and display the figurines as in issue 34. Then display the Charlie Brown figurine on the left Chair.



Also set the Table with its legs fitted into the holes in the floor.

For those who wish to add extra details to the Salad Bowls

Modellers who wish to can add a little dark green and yellow acrylic paint to their salads made in issue 33 to enhance the colour.



Apply a little paint to the salads with a brush. The trick is to allow the paint to dry slightly before applying it.



Now squeeze out a little yellow paint and mix it with an equal amount of glue and a few drops of neutral detergent.



Mix a little yellow and blue to make a dark green colour, then add a few drops of neutral detergent.



Lightly and evenly add little dots of paint with the tip of a liner paintbrush, as if you were adding corn kernels to the salads.
