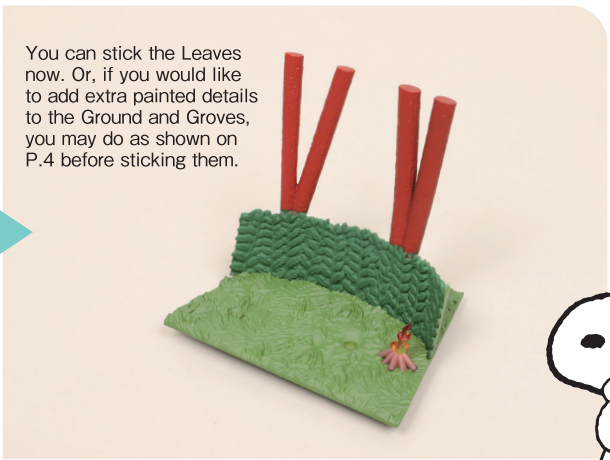
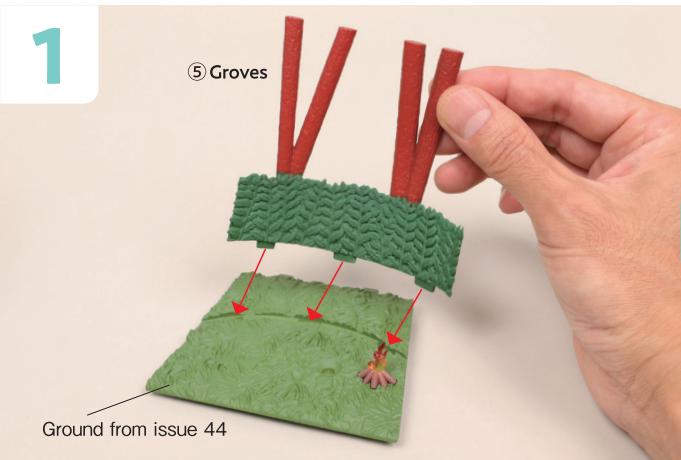
In this issue, we will assemble the background Groves and stick the Leaves to the Ground of the【Camping】scene. We will also assemble the Left and Right Walls, Back Wall and Ground to the Floorboard, and assemble the Exterior Walls.

⑥ Leaf Sheet A ⑦ Leaf Sheet B 【Figurine】⑧ Snoopy

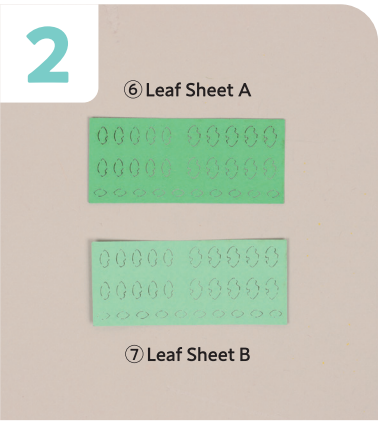

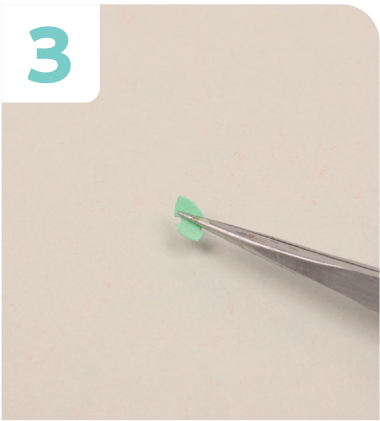
MAKING THE GROVES AND LEAVES



Remove the Ground temporarily assembled to the Back Wall in issue 44, then assemble the ⑤ Groves in the direction shown above by inserting its bottom protrusions into the grooves in the Ground. Apply a little quick-drying glue to the protrusions if it tends to come off.



Use a cutter to cut and remove the large, medium and small Leaves from the joints of ⑥ Leaf Sheet A and ⑦ Leaf Sheet B.



Fold each Leaf with tweezers as shown to make it look slightly more three-dimensional before sticking it.

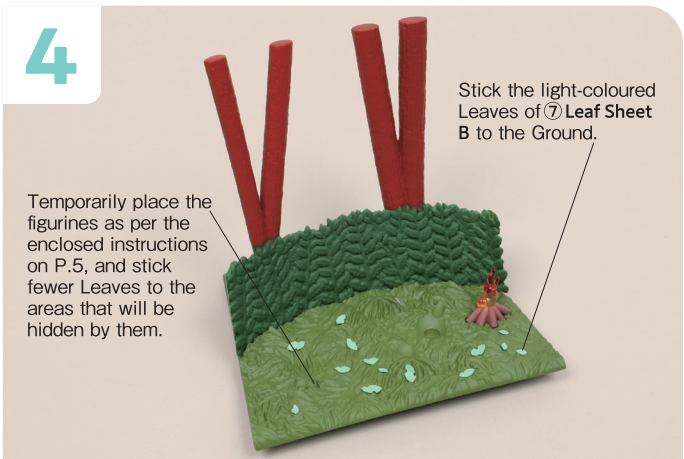


Using "matte medium" is convenient

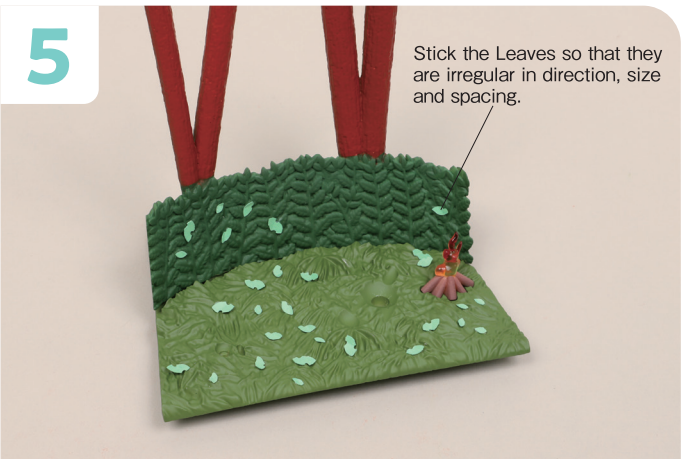


It is more convenient and less noticeable to use "matte medium" instead of wood glue to stick the Leaves, as it becomes transparent when it dries. Simply squeeze a small amount onto a palette plate or the like, dissolve it in water and apply it to the Leaves.

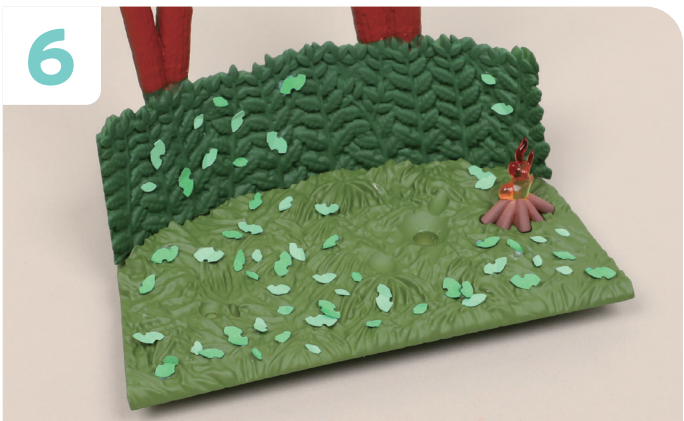
Making the Groves and Leaves



Stick the Leaves cut from ⑦ Leaf Sheet B to the Ground while checking the areas that will be hidden by the figurines.



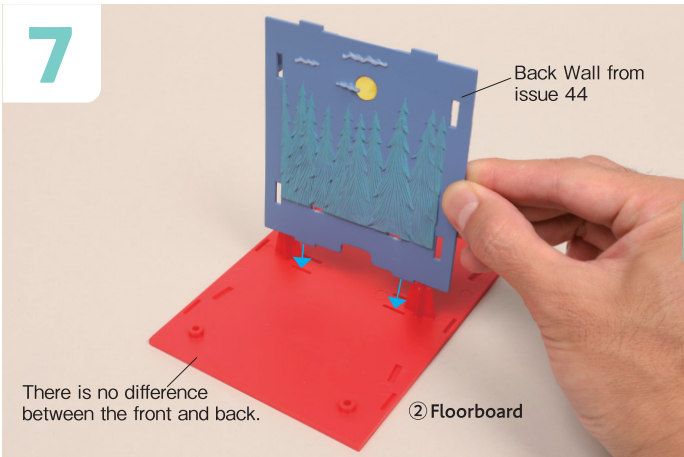
Stick the Leaves of ⑦ Leaf Sheet B to the Ground and the green area below the Groves in a well-balanced manner.



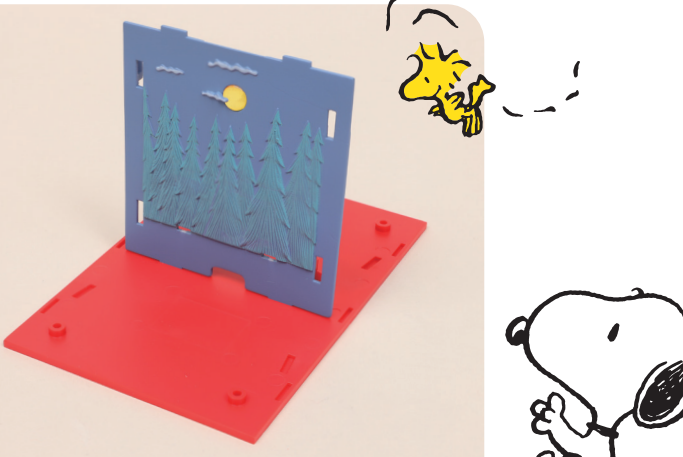
Similarly, stick the Leaves of ⑥ Leaf Sheet A to the Ground and below the Groves in a well-balanced manner.



ASSEMBLING THE FLOORBOARD, LEFT AND RIGHT WALLS



Assemble the Back Wall from issue 44 to the ② Floorboard. Apply a little quick-drying glue to the grooves in the Floorboard and insert the bottom protrusions of the Back Wall.



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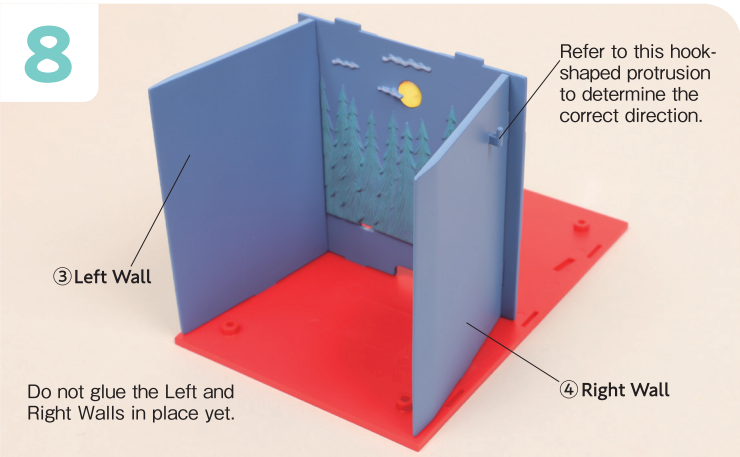

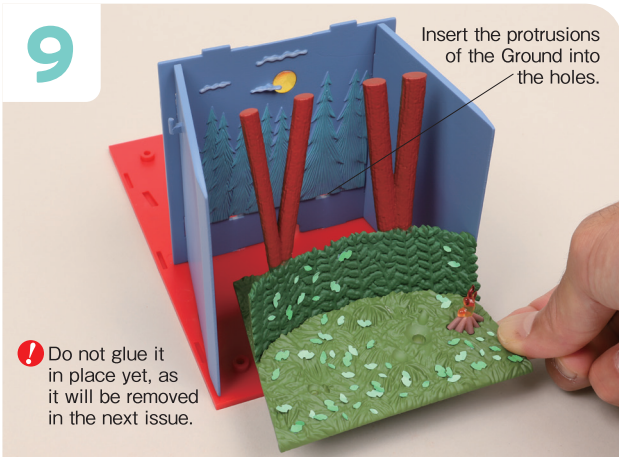

Assembling the Floorboard, Left and Right Walls

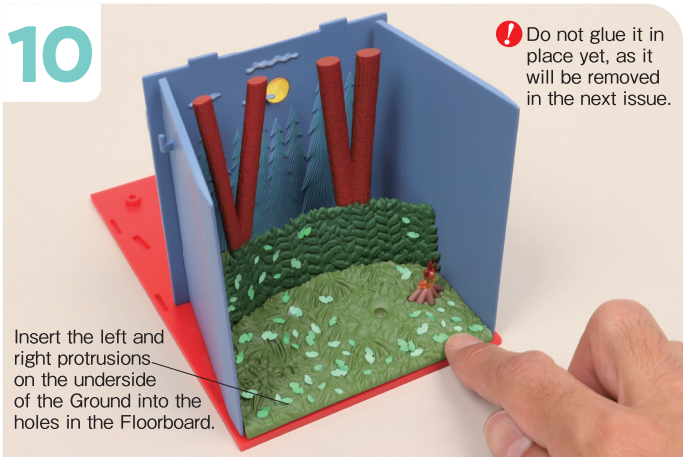


Assemble the ③ Left Wall on the left of the Floorboard and the ④ Right Wall on the right.



Now assemble the Ground by first inserting its two rear protrusions into the holes in the Back Wall.

Assembling the Floorboard, Left and Right Walls

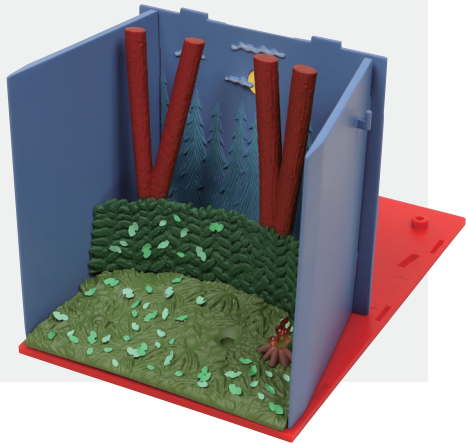


Next, press down the front edge of the Ground as you insert its bottom protrusions into the holes in the Floorboard.

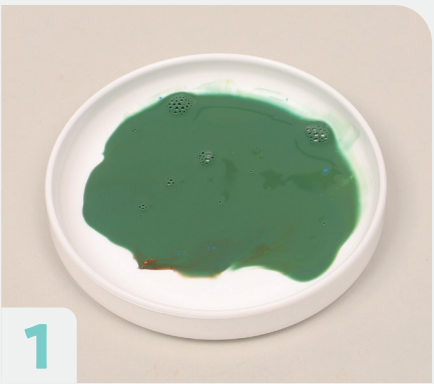
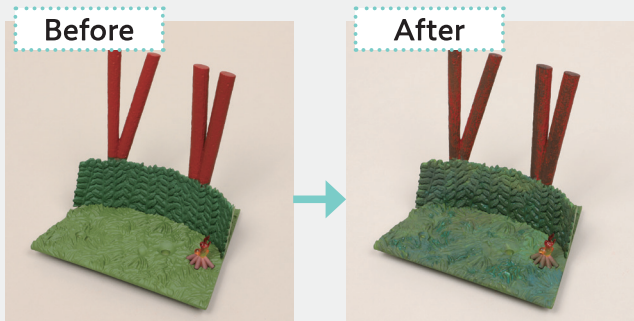


The box of the 【Camping】 scene is now complete. The Ground will be fixed in place after setting the LEDs and others to light the Campfire in the next issue.



For those who wish to add extra details to the Ground and Groves

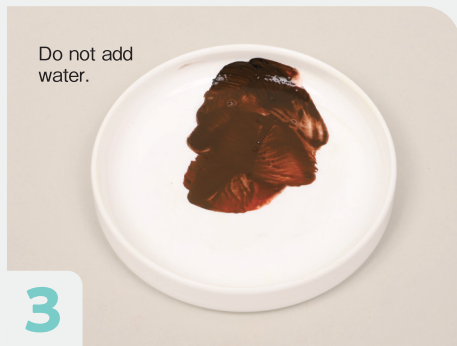
Modellers who wish to can add a touch of colour to the Ground and Groves to add depth and density to the scene. Let's colour the trees in the Groves and the Ground.



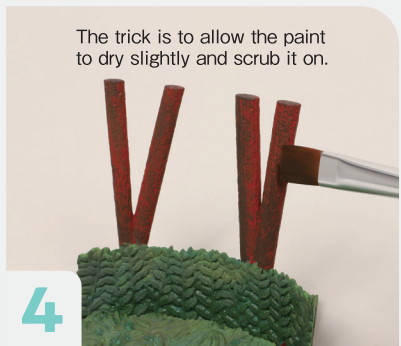
Squeeze out one part yellow-green, two parts spring blue and a small amount of brown paint and mix with five parts water and a few drops of neutral detergent.



Dip the brush in the paint and apply it to the Ground. The trick is to paint the colour slightly unevenly. Also paint the green area below the Groves in the same manner.



Mix brown paint with twice as much black and a few drops of neutral detergent without adding water.



The trick is to allow the paint to dry slightly and scrub it on. Dip the brush in a small amount of paint and apply it to the trunks. The trick is to allow the paint to dry slightly and scrub it on.

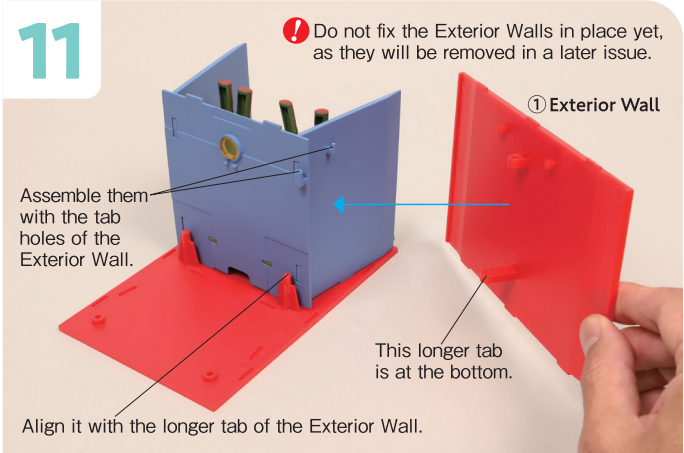


Displaying the figurine

Now assemble the ⑧ Snoopy figurine by aligning its bottom protrusion and so on with the hole and dent in the Ground. Do not glue it in place yet, as it will be removed in the next issue.



ASSEMBLING THE LEFT AND RIGHT EXTERIOR WALLS



The ① Exterior Walls will be fixed in place in a later issue. For now, we will assemble them unfixed. First, align the protrusions and tabs to assemble the Exterior Wall on one side.

Assemble another Exterior Wall on the opposite side in the same way to complete the assembly. We will assemble the LEDs and more in the next issue to complete the 【Camping】 scene.
