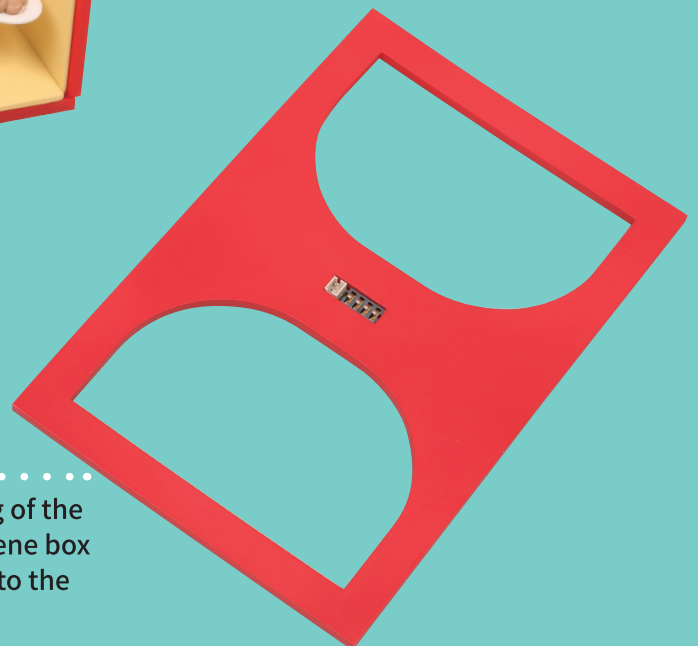

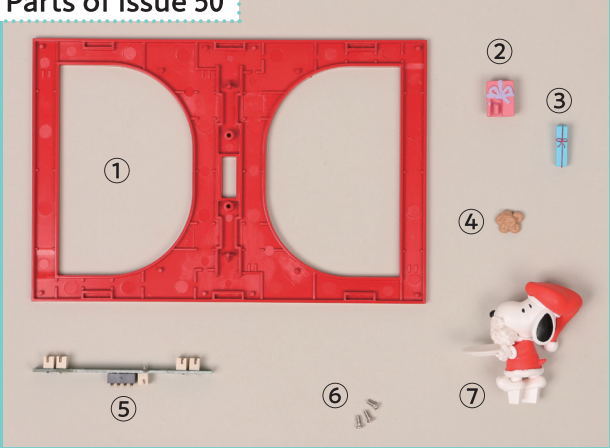

Assembling the Ceiling

We will display the Gifts by the Christmas Tree in the 【Santa Claus】 scene and place the Cookies on the Snoopy figurine's plate. We will also assemble the Circuit Board to the Ceiling Top Panel of the 【Woodstock's Nest/Football】 scene box.

- ① Ceiling Top Panel
- ② Gift A
- ③ Gift B
- ④ Cookies
- ⑤ Circuit Board
- ⑥ Screw (PM2×4 mm)×3 (1 for spare)
- ⑦ Snoopy
- ⑦ Snoopy

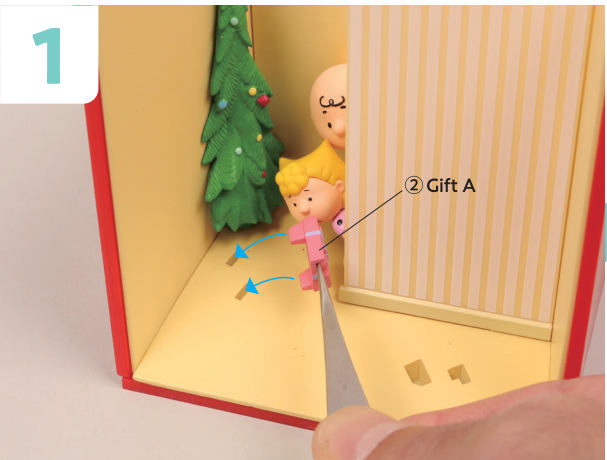


Making the Gifts and Cookies

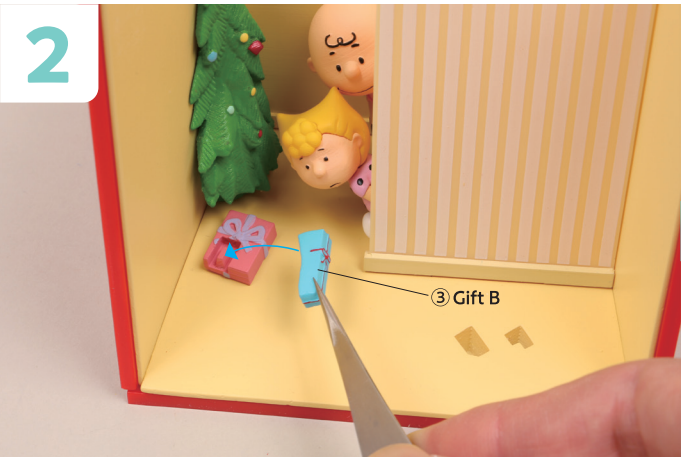


Assemble the ⑦ Snoopy figurine by inserting the protrusions under his feet into the holes in the Floor.

MAKING THE GIFTS AND COOKIES



Get ready the 【Santa Claus】 scene assembled in issue 49 and assemble ② Gift A to the Floor by inserting its protrusions into the holes in the Floor.



Then assemble ③ Gift B in the same manner.



The ④ Cookies can be secured with double-sided tape. First, apply a small piece of cut double-sided tape to the back.



Peel off the double-sided tape backing and place the Cookies on the plate that Snoopy is holding.



Secure the ④ Cookies in place so they look balanced when viewed from the front.

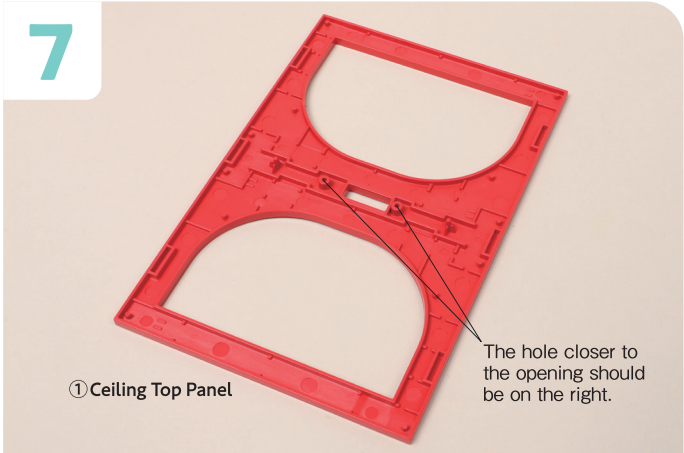


With the addition of the Gifts, Snoopy figurine, etc., the 【Santa Claus】 scene is now complete.

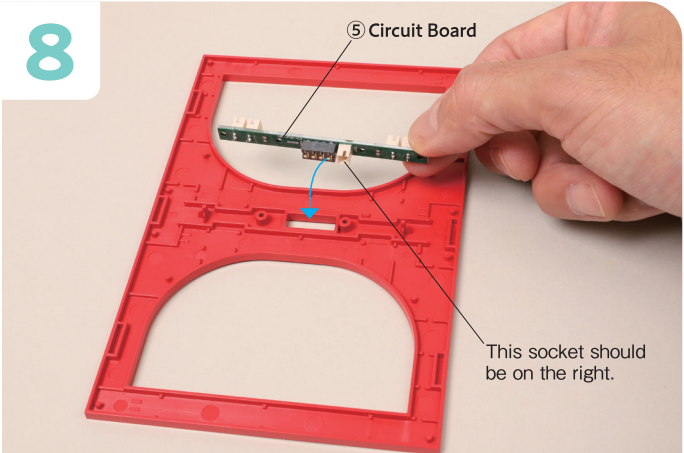




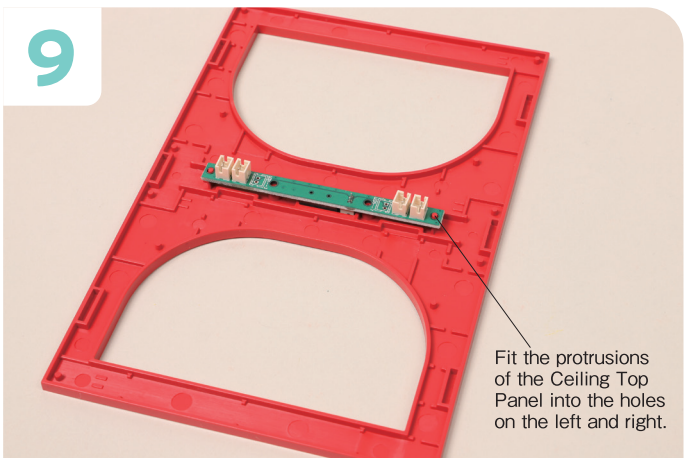
ASSEMBLING THE CEILING



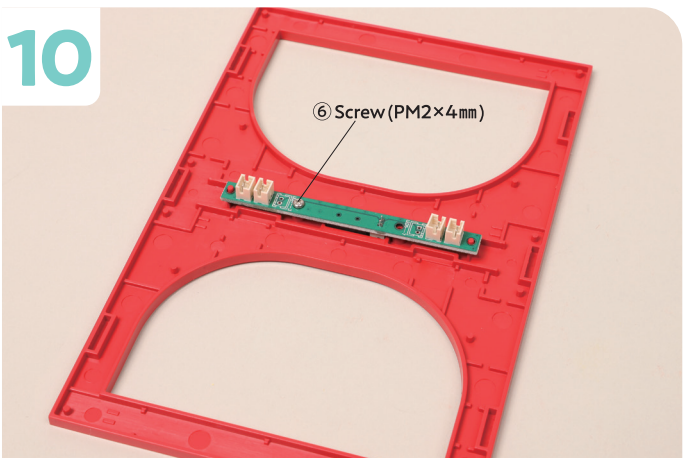
Check the orientation of the ① Ceiling Top Panel—the holes on either side of the rectangular opening in the middle are positioned differently. The hole closer to the opening should be on the right.



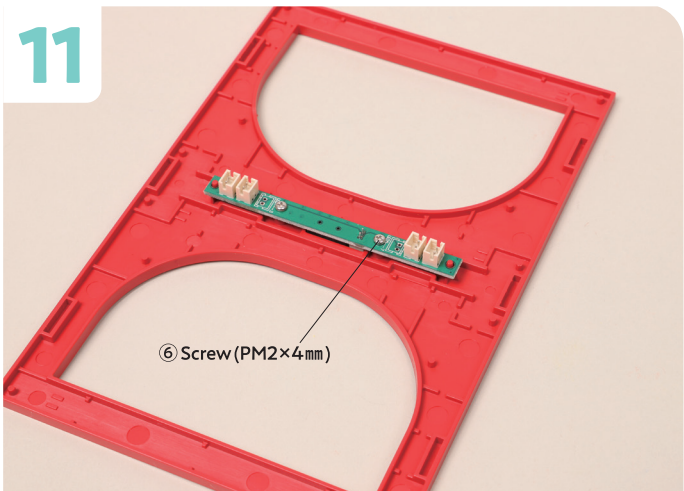
Assemble the ⑤ Circuit Board to the Ceiling Top Panel by fitting its terminal part into the opening in the Ceiling Top Panel.



Fit the protrusions of the Ceiling Top Panel into the holes on the left and right and then assemble the Circuit Board.



Tighten a ⑥ Screw (PM2×4mm) into the hole in the Circuit Board at the position indicated above.

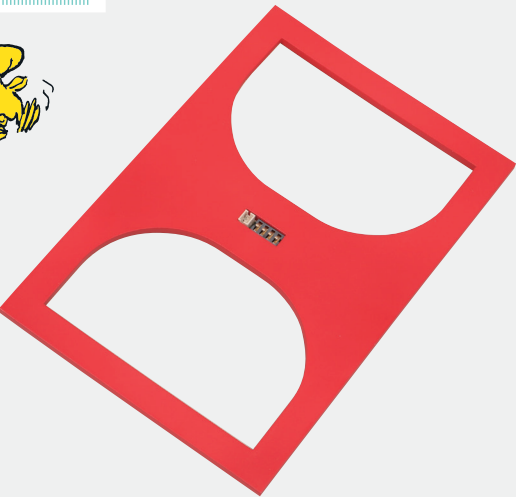


Tighten and secure another ⑥ Screw (PM2×4mm) into the remaining hole in the Circuit Board in the same manner.

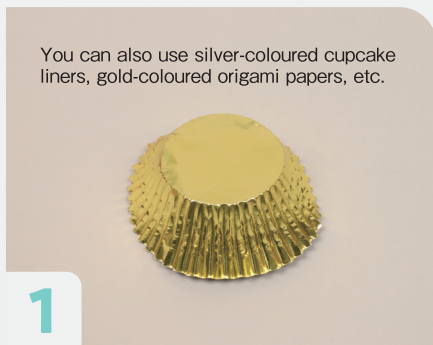
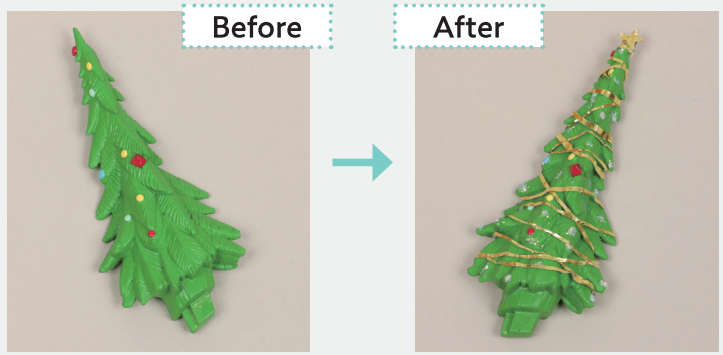


That finishes the Ceiling for the【Woodstock's Nest/Football】scene. We will fit the LEDs in a later issue.



For those who wish to add extra festive details to the Christmas Tree

Modellers who wish to can add an extra touch to make your Christmas Tree more festive and glamorous. Here we will show you how to make ornaments using cupcake liners and other materials—arrange the materials and colours as desired to personalise your Christmas Tree.



We are using a cupcake liner here. You can also use silver- or gold-coloured origami paper if you like.



Cut the cupcake liner with scissors and remove the bottom.



Cut a thin strip of about 1 mm width along the periphery of the cupcake liner.



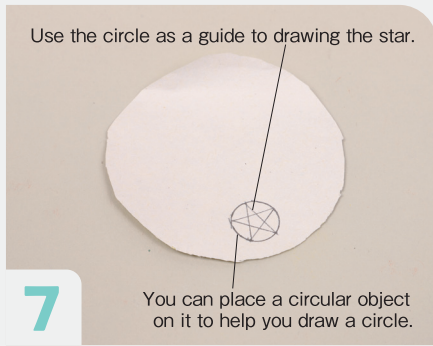
Prepare several thin strips. If you are using origami paper, better fold or crease it so it is not flat.



Now glue them onto the Christmas Tree in a well-balanced manner. Fold and affix the ends over to the back and then apply glue here and there along the strip.



Apply lame paint here and there on the tree directly without dissolving it in water to add glitter.



We will use the bottom part of the cupcake liner to make a star-shaped ornament. First, draw a star inside a circle of about 6 mm in diameter.



Cut along the drawn line. You can use a cutter to do so.



Glue the cut star-shaped ornament to the top of the tree. Also glue one to its back for a more three-dimensional look.
