We will start assembling the 【Figure Skating】 scene in this issue. Let's assemble the Back Wall and Ground to the opposite side of the 【Surfboard】 scene previously assembled, and then assemble the Trees and Lake Surface.

Assembling the Back Wall and Ground
Making the Trees and Lake Surface

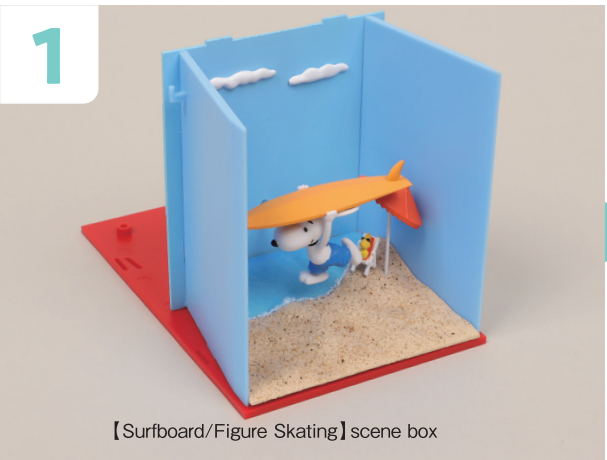
We will start assembling the【Figure Skating】scene in this issue. Let's assemble the Back Wall and Ground to the opposite side of the【Surfboard】scene previously assembled, and assemble the Trees and Lake Surface to the snowy Ground.

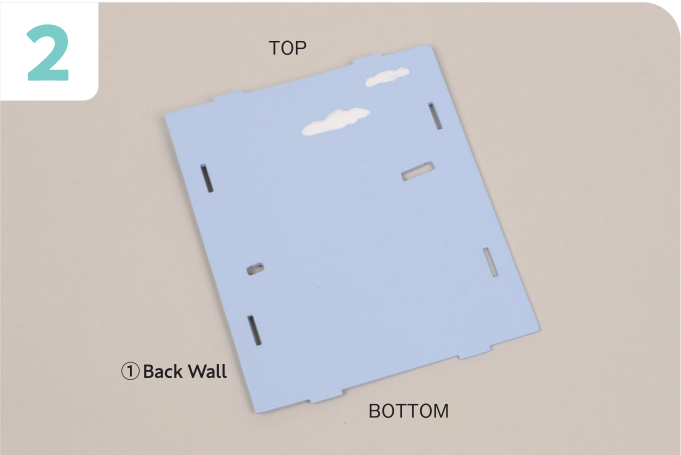
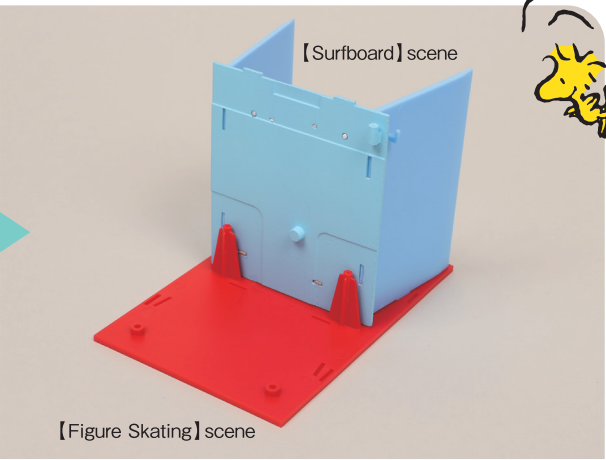


① Back Wall ② Ground ③ Lake Surface ④ Trees 【Figurine】 ⑤ Snoopy

ASSEMBLING THE BACK WALL AND GROUND



The【Figure Skating】scene is on the opposite side of the【Surfboard】scene. First, get ready the【Surfboard/ Figure Skating】scene box previously assembled.

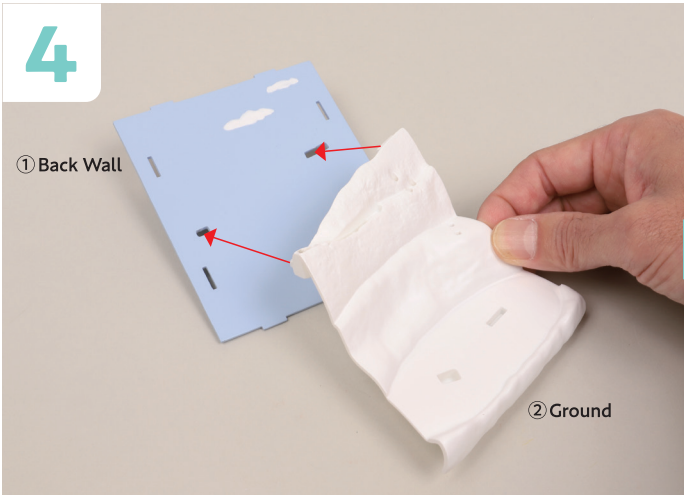


Make sure the ① Back Wall is facing the correct direction by referring to the clouds.

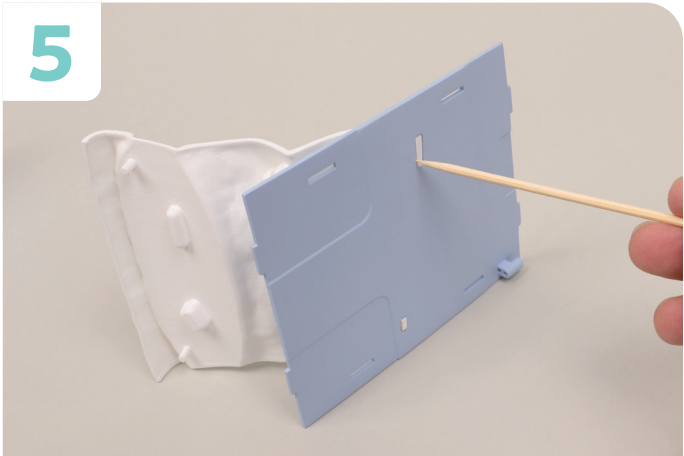


Check the orientation of the ② Ground as well.

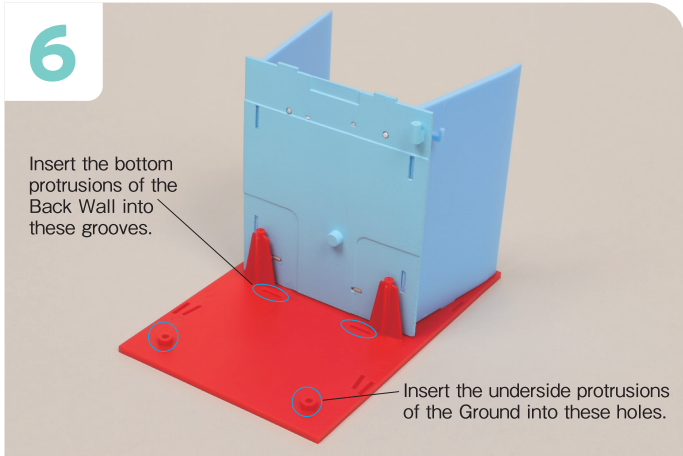
Assembling the Back Wall and Ground



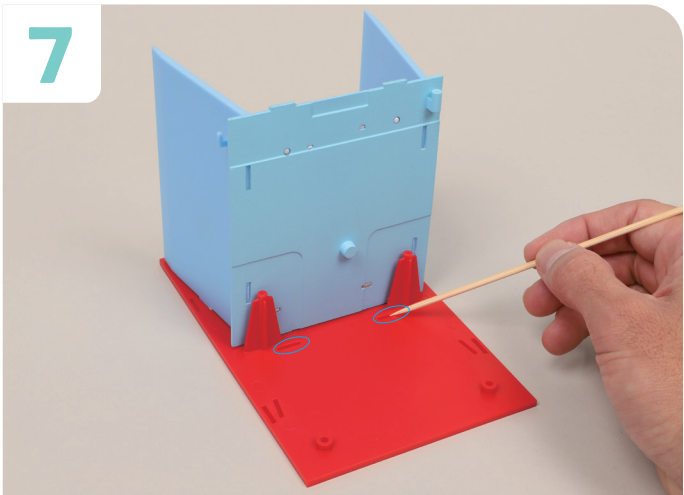
Assemble the ② Ground to the ① Back Wall by inserting its upper protrusions into the holes in the Back Wall.



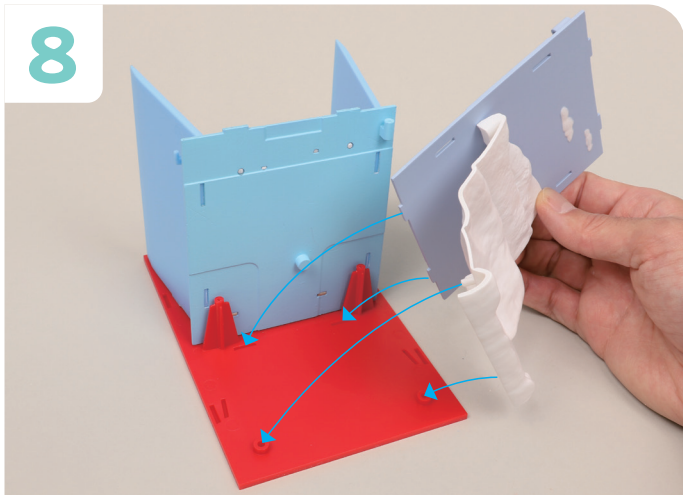
Use the tip of a toothpick or the like to apply a little quick-drying glue to the hole at the back of the Back Wall where the Ground's protrusion is inserted.



Identify the grooves and holes at the front and back of the Floorboard of the【Figure Skating】scene.



Apply a little quick-drying glue to the grooves at the back of the Floorboard identified in step 6 with the tip of a toothpick or the like.



Before the glue dries, fit the assembled parts from step 5 to the Floorboard by inserting the Back Wall's bottom protrusions and the Ground's underside protrusions into the grooves and holes in the Floorboard.

Assembling the Back Wall and Ground

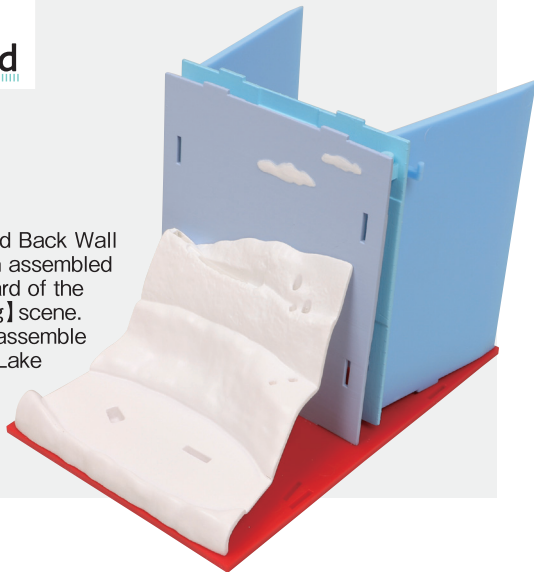


Press down the front edge of the Ground and insert its underside protrusions firmly into the holes in the Floorboard.

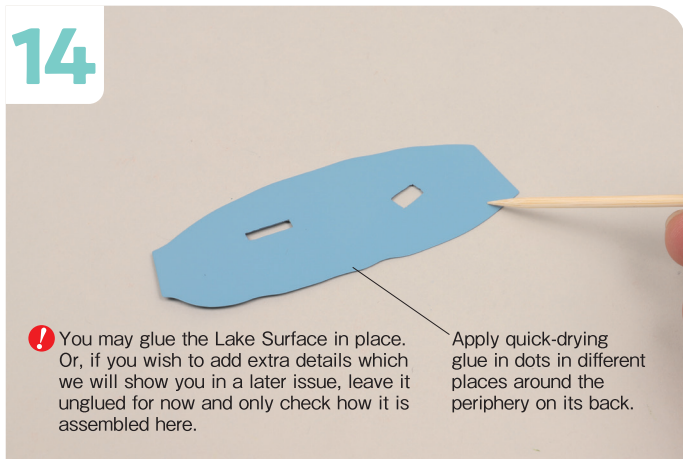

The Ground and Back Wall have now been assembled to the Floorboard of the 【Figure Skating】 scene. Let's go on to assemble the Trees and Lake Surface to the Ground.

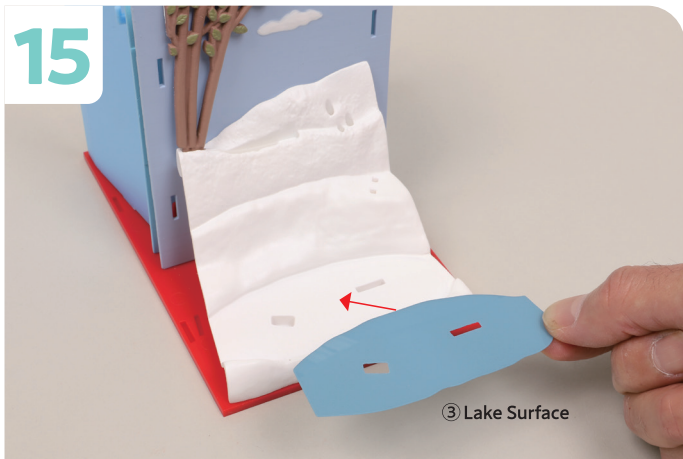


Making the Trees and Lake Surface



! You may glue the Lake Surface in place. Or, if you wish to add extra details which we will show you in a later issue, leave it unglued for now and only check how it is assembled here. Apply quick-drying glue in dots in different places around the periphery on its back.

To glue the ③ Lake Surface, apply quick-drying glue in dots in different places around the periphery on its back. The trick is not to apply too much to prevent it from oozing out after assembly.

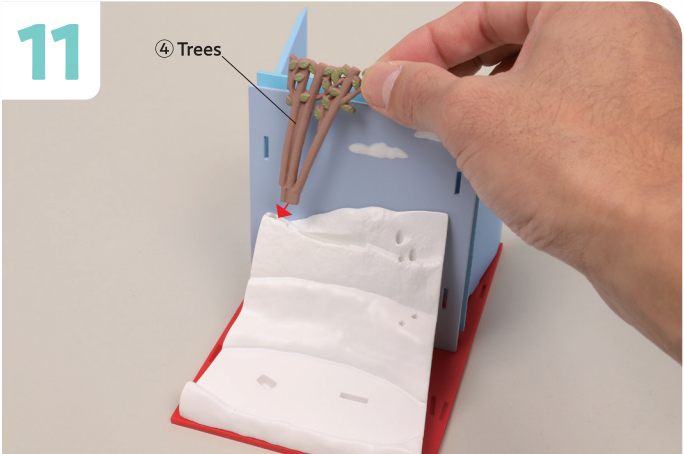


Assemble the ③ Lake Surface to the Ground.

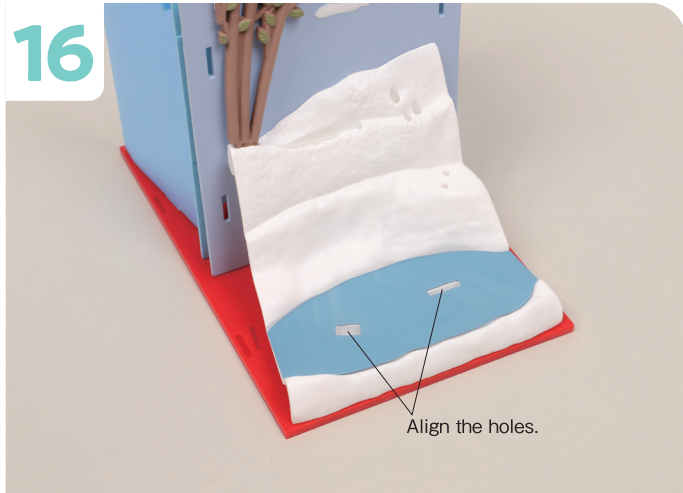
MAKING THE TREES AND LAKE SURFACE



Identify the holes at the back of the Ground in the position shown above.



Assemble the ④ Trees by inserting the bottom protrusion into the hole in the Ground identified in step 10.



The holes in the ③ Lake Surface should align with the holes in the Ground.

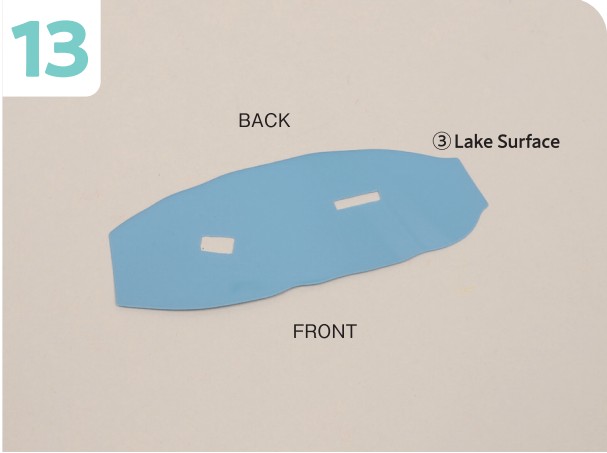
Issue 51 Completed



An icy Lake Surface has now been added to the Ground and a grove of Trees has been set in the background. We will be adding Woods and Trees to the background in the next issue.



Insert the ④ Trees all the way to the bottom of the hole.



Make sure the front and back of the ③ Lake Surface are correctly oriented by referring to the holes.



Adding the figurine

Insert the protrusion under the ⑤ Snoopy figurine's foot into the holes in both the Lake Surface and the Ground.



You may glue the Snoopy figurine in place. Or, if you wish to add extra details which we will show you in a later issue, leave it unglued for now.
